Anatomical demonstration; Dissection

Introduction

The teaching of anatomy through dissection had its roots in the medieval university. Early manuscripts from Salerno in the twelfth century included dissection manuals written to explain the dissection of a pig for teaching anatomy (Corner 1927), and human cadavers were certainly dissected for teaching purposes in the medical school at Bologna by the early fourteenth century as evidence by the dissection manual of Mondino de' Liuzzi, a member of the medical faculty there (Singer 1925). Anatomical demonstrations involving dissection were codified into university statutes in Italy in the fifteenth century, and by the sixteenth century, anatomy had become an important subject, and the demonstrations grew

in prominence. The first permanent anatomy theaters were not built until second half of the century, however, and they served a variety of purposes in addition to being venues for anatomical demonstrations. By the seventeenth century, anatomical demonstrations also occurred outside medical schools in a variety of spaces and before a variety of audiences.

The Anatomical Demonstration

Anatomy did not take a formal place in the university curriculum until later in the sixteenth century. Earlier than that, rather than prescribe lectures on anatomy in the normal rotation of the curriculum and appoint chairs of anatomy to teach it, an annual anatomy lesson, a demonstration employing dissection of a human body, was used to teach the students. Despite this unique approach, anatomy was an important subject that permeated the concepts of medical theory and practice, not to mention surgery and even natural philosophy (Grendler 2002).

The anatomical demonstration followed a specific order first established by Mondino and in place well into the sixteenth century. This order accommodated the decay of the body by beginning with the parts that were corrupted first and then proceeding to other organs. As Mondino described it, the body was divided into three sections, often referred to as venters or bellies. The first, and lowest, venter included the organs in the

The Anatomy Theater Nadine Sabra Meyer, 2007 During the Renaissance anatomical theaters cropped up in cities all over Europe anatomists performed dissections open to the general public and they circulated illustrations which had a remarkable resemblance to the pornography of the period I wrote the first section of The Anatomy Theater in response to these images hoping to enter the images from multiple perspectives aligning the poems voices variously with the anatomist the artist the viewer or the dissected The illustrations are complex contradictory and stirring because the issues they touch on are so central to us death salvation decomposition transience gender love healing sexuality violence knowledge science power and beauty to name those that come to mind As the book progressed and I left the Renaissance anatomists the subjects of poems in the subsequent three sections of the book varied widely from issues of my own health to meditations on paintings from different time periods to poems imagining the death of Renaissance poet John Donne I found nonetheless that similar preoccupations rose through the poems issues of how through various practices we glean information of the body I think of the book's title The Anatomy Theater as pointing not only as it does in the first section to the literal site of Renaissance anatomical learning but also to the many anatomical theaters the many theaters of the body those structures of thought religious artistic medical through which we understand the body

The Theatre of the Body Kate Cregan, 2009 This study is a threefold investigation of understandings of embodiment as displayed in the playhouses courthouses and anatomy theatres of London between 1540 and 1696 These dates mark the waxing and waning of the Worshipful Company of Barber Surgeons domination of the practice of dissection in London In 1540 Henry VIII gave them his approval and encouragement but by 1696 Edward Ravenscroft's The Anatomist Or the Sham Doctor staged their loss of power This loss of power the book contends is symptomatic of a major shift in the concept of embodiment The book explains the changing understanding of the human body throughout this period by analysis of the interplay between the texts used in and the material practices of three specific public sites the public playhouses the Sessions House and the Anatomy Theatre of the Worshipful Company of Barber Surgeons of London Using an approach that

combines the socially textured understandings of fields of practice found in Bourdieu with the interpretations of progression across time found in Elias and Foucault. The Theatre of the Body demonstrates how the three fields of drama, law, and medicine are intimately interconnected in that process. In presenting this analysis, the author argues that the quality of embodiment begins to shift during this period from the mid sixteenth century and throughout the course of the seventeenth century.
