between his sons Polyneices and Eteocles In Antigone the protagonist is Oedipus daughter Antigone She is faced with the choice of allowing her brother Polyneices body to remain unburied outside the city walls exposed to the ravages of wild animals or to bury him and face death The king of the land Creon has forbidden the burial of Polyneices for he was a traitor to the city Antigone decides to bury his body and face the consequences of her actions Creon sentences her to death Eventually Creon is convinced to free Antigone from her punishment but his decision comes too late and Antigone commits suicide Her suicide triggers the suicide of two others close to King Creon his son Haemon who was to wed Antigone and his wife Eurydice who commits suicide after losing her only surviving son *The Three Theban Plays* Sophocles,2015-07-18

The Three Theban Plays: Antigone; Oedipus the King; Oedipus at Colonus By Sophocles, 2016-11-21 BOOK ONE Antigone is a tragedy by Sophocles written in or before 441 BC It is the third of the three Theban plays but was the first written chronologically The play expands on the Theban legend that predated it and picks up where Aeschylus Seven Against Thebes ends BOOK TWO Oedipus Rex also known by its Greek title Oedipus Tyrannus or Oedipus the King is an Athenian tragedy by Sophocles that was first performed around 429 BC Originally to the ancient Greeks the title was simply Oedipus as it is referred to by Aristotle in the Poetics It is thought to have been renamed Oedipus Tyrannus to distinguish it from Oedipus at Colonus In antiquity the term tyrant referred to a ruler but it did not necessarily have a negative connotation Of his three Theban plays that have survived and that deal with the story of Oedipus Oedipus Rex was the second to be written However in terms of the chronology of events that the plays describe it comes first followed by Oedipus at Colonus and then Antigone BOOK THREE Oedipus at Colonus is one of the three Theban plays of the Athenian tragedian Sophocles It was written shortly before Sophocles death in 406 BC and produced by his grandson also called Sophocles at the Festival of Dionysus in 401 BC In the timeline of the plays the events of Oedipus at Colonus occur after Oedipus the King and before Antigone however it was the last of Sophocles three Theban plays to be written The play describes the end of Oedipus tragic life Legends differ as to the site of Oedipus death Sophocles set the place at Colonus a

presentation of the plot He also developed his characters to a greater extent than earlier playwrights such as Aeschylus
