The Third Wave of Democratization in Latin America Frances Hagopian, Scott Mainwaring, 2005 The late twentieth century witnessed the birth of an impressive number of new democracies in Latin America This wave of democratization since 1978 has been by far the broadest and most durable in the history of Latin America but many of the resulting democratic regimes also suffer from profound deficiencies What caused democratic regimes to emerge and survive What are their main achievements and shortcomings This volume offers an ambitious and comprehensive overview of the unprecedented advances as well as the setbacks in the post 1978 wave of democratization It seeks to explain the sea change from a region dominated by authoritarian regimes to one in which openly authoritarian regimes are the rare exception and it analyzes why some countries have achieved striking gains in democratization while others have experienced erosions The book presents general theoretical arguments about what causes and sustains democracy and analyses of nine compelling country cases

The Civil Sphere in Latin America Jeffrey C. Emergency Politics in the Third Wave of Democracy Claire Wright, 2015-12-09 Emergency Politics in the Third Wave of Democracy aims to make an important contribution to the study of emergency politics by offering an up to date study of how it works in practice Specifically it studies the uses given to the regime of exception mechanism in Bolivia Ecuador and Peru in the first decade of the 21st century and analyzes potential incompatibilities with the two pillars of democratic governability efficiency and legitimacy This book offers a thorough review of existing literature on emergency politics offering conceptual clarification identifying three types or paradigms of emergency politics repressive administrative and disaster and pointing to regimes of exception as a useful route to their study It also provides an overview of emergency politics in Latin America throughout history pointing to the predominance of regimes of exception and the repressive paradigm The book describes the continuity of the repressive paradigm in Peruvian emergency politics to deal with both social protest and the apparent threat of organized crime and terrorism as well as how Bolivia has shifted from a repressive to a disaster paradigm in the

face of pressure to deal with climate change It also analyzes the predominance of an administrative paradigm in Ecuadorian emergency politics in the context of weak institutions and difficulties in implementing policy as well as a populist style of leadership Ultimately the book offers some best practices in relation to the design and use of regimes of exception in democratic contexts Other studies on emergency politics tend to focus on legal or formal issues in the context of the United States War on Terror This study is decidedly political and empirical in focus offering analysis and interpretation as a result of intensive fieldwork carried out by the author in Bolivia Ecuador and Peru Consequently this volume offers important contributions to our understanding of emergency politics in general with evidence from the periphery as well as to our understanding of democratization processes in the Third Wave

Brandon Van Dyck investigates these questions in the context of the contemporary Latin American left. He argues that stable parties are not an outgrowth of democracy. On the contrary, contemporary democracy impedes successful party building. To construct a durable party, elites must invest time and labor and they must share power with activists. Because today's elites have access to party substitutes like mass media, they can win votes without making such sacrifices in time, labor, and autonomy. Only under conditions of soft authoritarianism do office-seeking elites have a strong electoral incentive to invest in party building. Van Dyck illustrates this argument through a comparative analysis of four new left parties in Latin America: two that collapsed and two that survived.

Religion and Democracy Carsten Anckar, 2021-11-29. He also discusses the extent to which religious minorities are under increasing pressure in secularized environments, prospects for democracy in the MENA region a decade after the Arab Spring, the growing influence of evangelical Christianity in Latin America, and how increasing levels of religious conflict in Asia and the Pacific as well as in Sub-Saharan Africa pose a threat to the emergence and survival of democracy. which is why they are reproduced differently Using a multi method approach *Democrats and Autocrats* shows that within country alternative trajectories of SUR continuity in Argentina and Mexico result first and foremost from the capacity or lack thereof of national incumbents to wield power over SURs and subnational autocrats Contrary to conventional wisdom the book argues that there are multiple pathways for SURs reproduction within democratic countries These pathways in turn are determined by a specific combination of intergovernmental interactions all of which are shaped by institutional and economic national and subnational variables The explanation of SUR continuity advanced in this book is tested in contemporary Argentina and Mexico using a multi method approach Both quantitative and qualitative methods as well as cross national and within country comparisons are employed to test pathways of SUR continuity in two of Latin America s largest countries
