and translators working in the areas of translation and translation theory **Translating China as Cross-Identity Performance** James St. André, 2018-05-31 James St André applies the perspective of cross identity performance to the translation of a wide variety of Chinese texts into English and French from the eighteenth to the twentieth centuries Drawing on scholarship in cultural studies queer studies and anthropology the author argues that many cross identity performance techniques including blackface passing drag mimicry and masquerade provide insights into the history of translation practice He makes a strong case for situating translation in its historical social and cultural milieu reading translated texts alongside a wide variety of other materials that helped shape the image of John Chinaman A reading of the life and works of George Psalmanazar whose cross identity performance as a native of Formosa enlivened early eighteenth century salons opens the volume and provides a bridge between the book s theoretical framework and its examination of Chinese European interactions The core of the book consists of a chronological series of cases each of which illustrates the use of a different type of cross identity performance to better understand translation practice St Andr provides close readings of early pseudotranslations including Marana s Turkish Spy 1691 and Goldsmith s Citizen of the World 1762 as well as adaptations of Hatchett s The Chinese Orphan 1741 and Voltaire s Orphelin de la Chine 1756 Later chapters explore Davis s translation of Sorrows of Han 1829 and genuine translations of nonfictional material mainly by employees of the East India Company The focus then shifts to oral aural aspects of early translation practice in the nineteenth century using the concept of mimicry to examine interactions between Pidgin English and translation in the popular press Finally the work of two early modern Chinese translators Gu Hongming and Lin Yutang is examined as masquerade Offering an original and innovative study of genres of writing that are traditionally examined in isolation St Andr s work provides a fascinating examination of the way three cultures interacted through the shifting encounters of fiction translation and nonfiction and in the process helped establish and shape the way Chinese were represented The book represents a major contribution to translation studies Chinese cultural studies postcolonial studies and gender criticism **Thinking Through the Skin** Sara Ahmed, Jackie Stacey, 2003-09-02 This exciting collection of work from leading feminist scholars including Elspeth Probyn Penelope Deutscher and Chantal Nadeau engages with and extends the growing feminist literature on lived and imagined embodiment and argues for consideration of the skin as a site where bodies take form already written upon but open to endless re inscription Individual chapters consider such issues as the significance of piercing tattooing and tanning the assault of self harm upon the skin the relation between body painting and the land among the indigenous people of Australia and the cultural economy of fur in Canada Pierced mutilated and marked mortified and glorified scarred by disease and stretched and enveloping the skin of another in pregnancy skin is seen here as both a boundary and a point of connection the place where one touches and is touched by others both the most private of experiences and the most public marker of a raced sexed and national history **Translation Theory and Development Studies** Kobus Marais, 2014-07-16 This book aims to

untranslatable But many poems in English are also translations Pope's Iliad Pound's Cathay and Dryden's Aeneis are only the most obvious examples The Poetry of Translation explodes this paradox launching a new theoretical approach to translation and developing it through readings of English poem translations both major and neglected from Chaucer and Petrarch to Homer and Logue The word translation includes within itself a picture of something being carried across This image gives a misleading idea of what goes on in any translation and poets have been quick to dislodge it with other metaphors Poetry translation can be a process of opening of pursuing desire or succumbing to passion of taking a view or zooming in of dying metamorphosing or bringing to life These are the dominant metaphors that have jostled the idea of carrying across in the history of poetry translation into English and they form the spine of Reynolds's discussion Where do these metaphors originate Wide ranging literary historical trends play their part but a more important factor is what goes on in the poem that is being translated Dryden thinks of himself as opening Virgil's Aeneid because he thinks Virgil's Aeneid opens fate into world history Pound tries to bring Propertius to life because death and rebirth are central to Propertius's poems In this way translation can continue the creativity of its originals The Poetry of Translation puts the translation of poetry back at the heart of English literature allowing the many great poem translations to be read anew
