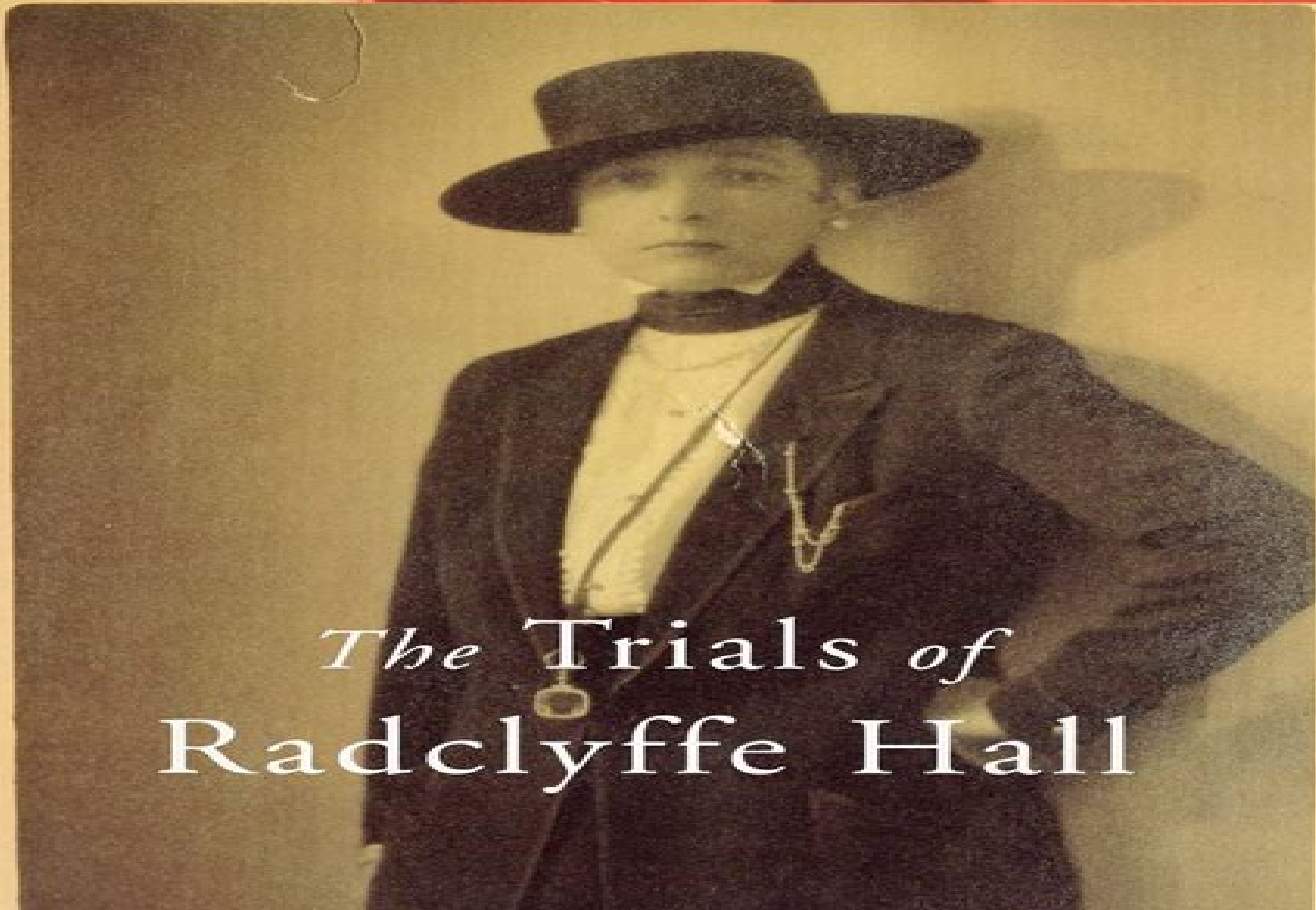

The Trials of Radclyffe Hall Diana Souhami, 2014-12-23 Diana Souhami's Lambda Award winning biography is a fascinating look at one of the twentieth century's most intriguing lesbian literary figures. Born in 1880, Marguerite Radclyffe Hall was a young unwanted child when her parents put an end to their tempestuous marriage by filing for divorce. She had already made tentative forays into lesbian love when her father died, leaving her an heiress at eighteen. Her income assured, Hall moved out of her mother's house, renamed herself John in honor of her great great grandfather, and divided her time among hunting, traveling, and pursuing women. She began to write songs, poetry, prose, and short stories, and achieved success as a novelist, but it was with the publication of *The Well of Loneliness* in 1928 that Radclyffe Hall became an internationally known figure. Dubbed the bible of lesbianism, the book caused a scandal on both sides of the Atlantic. Though moralistic in tone because of its subject matter, it was tried as obscene in America and in the United Kingdom, where it was censored under the Obscene Publications Act. *The Trials of Radclyffe Hall* is a fascinating, no-holds-barred account of the life of this controversial woman, including her torrid relationship with the married artist Una Troubridge, who was Hall's devoted partner for twenty-eight years.

Upstairs Andrew Kingsley Weatherhead,2000 Examines the role played by the large house in works by Woolfe Waugh Murdoch and others *Dirt for Art's Sake* Elisabeth Ladenson,2012-09-24 In *Dirt for Art s Sake* Elisabeth Ladenson recounts the most visible of modern obscenity trials involving scandalous books and their authors What she asks do these often colorful legal histories have to tell us about the works themselves and about a changing cultural climate that first treated them as filth and later celebrated them as masterpieces Ladenson s narrative starts with Madame Bovary Flaubert was tried in France in 1857 and finishes with Fanny Hill written in the eighteenth century put on trial in the United States in 1966 she considers along the way Les Fleurs du Mal Ulysses The Well of Loneliness Lady Chatterley s Lover Tropic of Cancer Lolita and the works of the Marquis de Sade Over the course of roughly a century Ladenson finds two ideas that had been circulating in the form of avant garde heresy gradually became accepted as truisms and eventually as grounds for legal defense The first is captured in the formula art for art s sake the notion that a work of art exists in a realm independent of conventional morality The second is realism vilified by its critics as dirt for dirt s sake In Ladenson s view the truth of the matter is closer to dirt for art s sake the idea that the work of art may legitimately include the representation of all aspects of life including the unpleasant and the sordid Ladenson also considers cinematic adaptations of these novels among them Vincente Minnelli s Madame Bovary Stanley Kubrick s Lolita and the 1997 remake directed by Adrian Lyne and various attempts to translate de Sade s works and life into film which faced similar censorship travails Written with a keen awareness of ongoing debates about free speech *Dirt for Art s Sake* traces the legal and social acceptance of controversial works with critical acumen and delightful wit **English Literary Sexology** H. In the book's final chapter, *How to Recognize a Lesbian*, Walker argues that strategies of visibility are at times deconstructed, at times reinscribed within contemporary lesbian feminist theory.

Toupie Lowther appears as a walk on character in many biographies of Radclyffe Hall and Una Troubridge In the years after WW1 she is invariably identified as a Lady Barbara Lowther however a quick look in Debrett's peerage will bring no further enlightenment But now identified by the author as May Lowther b 15th April 1874 the writer of this biography has been able to uncover much more of her family as well as her active and sporting life Her father's illegitimate birth his naval career and marriage to a Canadian young woman Her brother Claude Lowther of Herstmonceux Castle and Lowther's Lambs fame in WW1 As a young woman fencer in the early years of the 20th century and later as a popular tennis player both at home and in European tournaments the newspapers readily report her achievements Often with brief mentions of her sophisticated musical talent and well known passion for fast cars Towards the end of WW1 the Hackett Loather all Women Ambulance Unit attached to the French army remains unique in European history the women drivers serving both day and night under shellfire gas and bomb during the German Advance of 1918 After the war a later friendship with the writer Radcliffe Hall and her partner Una Troubridge takes her on a round of clubbing and rubbing in a post war lesbian and gay London this friendship was strangled forever after the publication of Hall's novel The Well of Loneliness its fiction clearly borrowed rather than invented Her later life sees her away from London making a new life with her goddaughter in the fine countryside of West Sussex **Who's Who in Gay and Lesbian History Vol.1** Robert Aldrich, Garry
