China's New Imperialism Yu-Ping Chang, 2023-02-14 This book discusses the nature of China's current international reassertion of itself and the thinking and attitudes which lie behind it It argues that the Chinese leadership has a strongly held view of its own high moral authority which emphasizes inclusion
