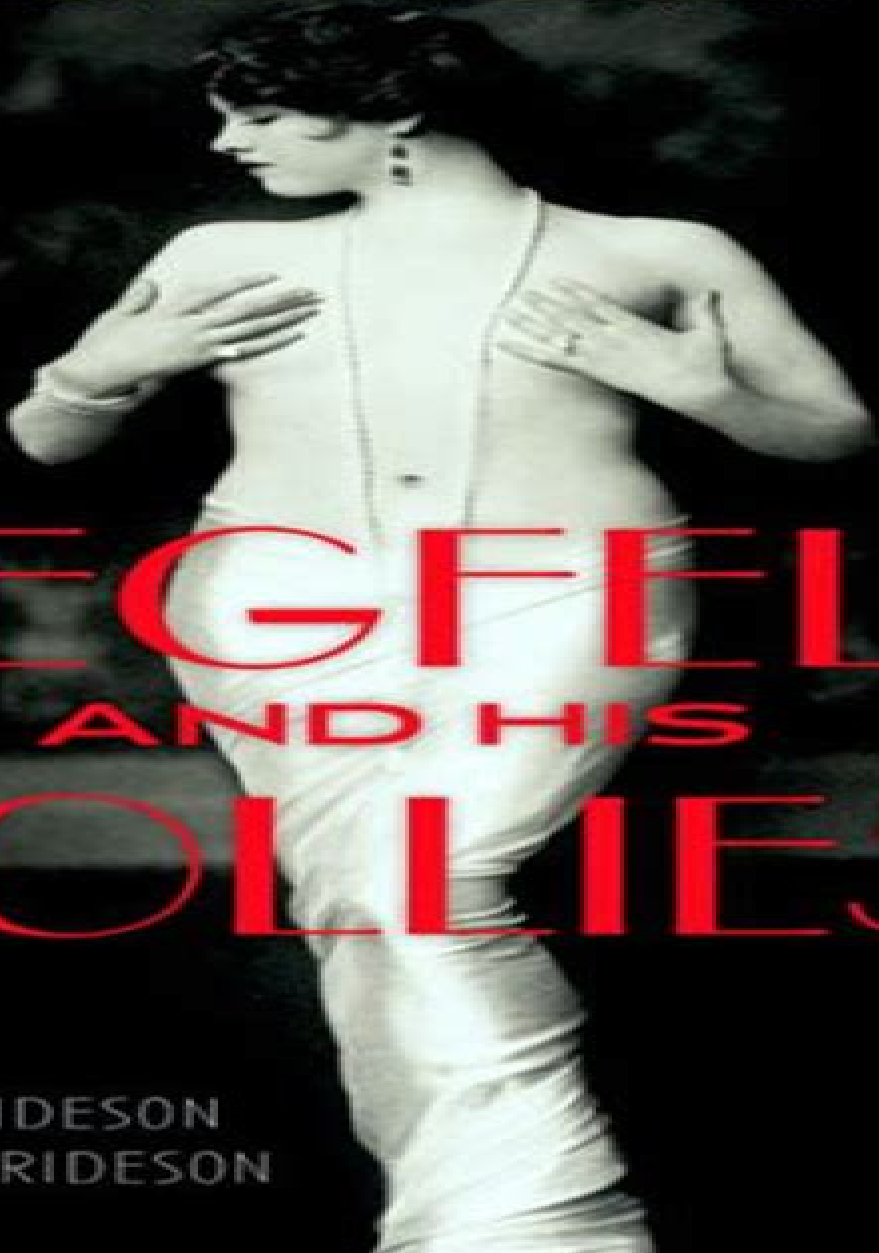

Christina Rice, 2021-06-15 By the early 1950s Jane Russell 1921 2011 should have been forgotten Her career was launched on what is arguably the most notorious advertising campaign in cinema history which invited filmgoers to see Howard Hughes s *The Outlaw* 1943 and to tussle with Russell Throughout the 1940s she was nicknamed the motionless picture actress and had only three films in theaters With such a slow inauspicious start most aspiring actresses would have given up or faded away Instead Russell carved out a place for herself in Hollywood and became a memorable and enduring star Christina Rice offers the first biography of the actress and activist perhaps most well known for her role in *Gentlemen Prefer Blondes* 1953 Despite the fact that her movie career was stalled for nearly a decade Russell s filmography is respectable She worked with some of Hollywood s most talented directors including Howard Hawks Raoul Walsh Nicholas Ray and Josef von Sternberg and held her own alongside costars such as Marilyn Monroe Robert Mitchum Clark Gable Vincent Price and Bob Hope She also learned how to fight back against Howard Hughes her boss for more than thirty five years and his marketing campaigns that exploited her physical appearance Beyond the screen Rice reveals Russell as a complex and confident woman She explores the star s years as a spokeswoman for Playtex as well as her deep faith and work as a Christian vocalist Rice also discusses Russell s leadership and patronage of the WAIF foundation which for many years served as the fundraising arm of the International Social Service ISS agency WAIF raised hundreds of thousands of dollars successfully lobbied Congress to change laws and resulted in the adoption of tens of thousands of orphaned children For Russell the work she did to help unite families overshadowed any of her onscreen achievements On the surface Jane Russell seemed to live a charmed life but Rice illuminates her darker moments and her personal struggles including her empowered reactions to the controversies surrounding her films and her feelings about being portrayed as a sex symbol This stunning first biography offers a fresh perspective on a star whose legacy endures not simply because she forged a notable film career but also because she effectively used her celebrity to benefit others

Charles Boyer John Baxter, 2021-11-23 Charles Boyer *The French Lover* is

the first biography of Boyer to exist in English in almost forty years Author John Baxter artfully presents the often tragic life of this often overlooked yet profoundly impactful French actor Baxter relates how Boyer 1899 1978 established himself in the theater and cinema of France confidently transitioning from silent film to sound and making a name for himself as a romantic leading man in Hollywood through the early 1940s During World War II Boyer put his career on hold to become politically active on behalf of his occupied home country Upon returning to the stage and screen Boyer adapted effortlessly to postwar character roles in both Europe and the United States He entered television in the 1950s as both producer and performer and then remade himself as a comedy performer in the 1960s Nominated four times for Academy Awards he was honored by the Academy only once a special honorary award received for his activities on behalf of France during World War II In an insightful analysis of Boyer s choice of roles during and after World War II Baxter shows that the actor possessed a shrewd perception of his image Baxter reveals how Boyer realizing his accent would always mark him as an outsider both embraced and subverted that identity Far from clinging to the performances that made him famous Boyer showed a readiness to break the mold Yet above all Baxter argues Boyer s greatest achievement was becoming the embodiment of exiles everywhere

of the Year and starred alongside Cary Grant in *Kiss Them for Me* 1957 Despite her popularity her appearance as the first celebrity in *Playboy* and her nude scene in *Promises Promises* 1963 cemented her reputation as an outsider By the 1960s Mansfield's film career had declined but she remained very popular with the public She capitalized on that popularity through in person and TV appearances nightclub appearances and stage productions Her larger than life life ended sadly when she passed away at age thirty four in a car accident Golden looks beyond Mansfield's flashy public image and tragic death to fully explore her life and legacy She discusses Mansfield's childhood her many loves including her famous on again off again relationship with Mikl's Mickey Hargitay her struggles with alcohol and her sometimes tumultuous family relationships She also considers Mansfield's enduring contributions to American popular culture and celebrity culture This funny engaging biography offers a nuanced portrait of a fascinating woman who loved every minute of life and lived each one to the fullest

Strictly Dynamite Eve Golden, 2023-09-19 Before Salma Hayek Eva Longoria and Penelope Cruz there was Lupe Velez one of the first Latin American stars to sweep past the xenophobia of old Hollywood and pave the way for future icons from around the world Her career began in the silent era when her beauty was enough to make it onto the silver screen but with the rise of talkies Velez could no longer hope to hide her Mexican accent Yet Velez proved to be a talented dramatic and comedic actress and singer and was much more versatile than Greta Garbo Katharine Hepburn Gloria Swanson and other legends of the time Velez starred in such films as *Hot Pepper* 1933 *Strictly Dynamite* 1934 and *Hollywood Party* 1934 and her popularity peaked in the 1940s after she appeared as Carmelita Fuentes in eight Mexican *Spitfire* films a series created to capitalize on Velez's reputed fiery personality The media emphasized the Mexican *Spitfire* persona and by many accounts Velez's private

life was as colorful as the characters she portrayed on screen Fan magazines mythologized her mysterious childhood in Mexico while mainstream publications obsessed over the drama of her romances with Gary Cooper Erich Maria Remarque and John Gilbert along with her stormy marriage to Johnny Weissmuller In 1944 a pregnant and unmarried Velez died of an intentional drug overdose Her tumultuous life and the circumstances surrounding her early death have been the subject of speculation and controversy In *Strictly Dynamite The Sensational Life of Lupe Velez* author Eve Golden uses extensive research to separate fact from fiction and offer a thorough and riveting examination of the real woman beneath the gossip columns caricature Through astute analysis of the actress's filmography and interviews Golden illuminates the path Velez blazed through Hollywood Her success was unexpected and extraordinary at a time when a distinctive accent was an obstacle and yet very few books have focused entirely on Velez's life and career Written with evenhandedness humor and empathy this biography finally gives the remarkable Mexican actress the unique and nuanced portrait she deserves

Michael Curtiz Alan K. Atkins, 2020-11-12 Harry Dean Stanton 1926 2017 got his start in Hollywood in TV productions such as Zane Grey Theater and Gunsmoke After a series of minor parts in forgettable westerns he gradually began to get film roles that showcased his laid back acting style appearing in Cool Hand Luke 1967 Kelly's Heroes 1970 The Godfather Part II 1974 and Alien 1979 He became a headliner in the eighties starring in Wim Wenders's moving Paris Texas 1984 and Alex Cox's Repo Man 1984 but it was his extraordinary skill as a character actor that established him as a revered cult figure and kept him in demand throughout his career Joseph B Atkins unwinds Stanton's enigmatic persona in the first biography of the man Vanity Fair memorialized as the philosopher poet of character acting He sheds light on Stanton's early life in West Irvine Kentucky exploring his difficult relationship with his Baptist parents his service in the Navy and the events that inspired him to drop out of college and pursue acting Atkins also chronicles Stanton's early years in California describing how he honed his craft at the renowned Pasadena Playhouse before breaking into television and movies In addition to examining the actor's acclaimed body of work Atkins also explores Harry Dean Stanton as a Hollywood legend following his years rooming with Jack Nicholson partying with David Crosby and Mama Cass jogging with Bob Dylan and playing poker with John Huston HD Stanton was scratched onto the wall of a jail cell in Easy Rider 1969 and painted on an exterior concrete wall in Drive He Said 1971 Critic Roger Ebert so admired the actor that he suggested the Stanton Walsh Rule which states that no movie featuring either Harry Dean Stanton or M Emmet Walsh in a supporting role can be altogether bad Harry Dean Stanton is often remembered for his crowd pleasing roles in movies like Pretty in Pink 1986 or Escape from New York 1981 but this impassioned biography illuminates the entirety of his incredible sixty year career Drawing on interviews with the actor's friends family and colleagues this much needed book offers an unprecedented look at a beloved figure *Film's First Family*
