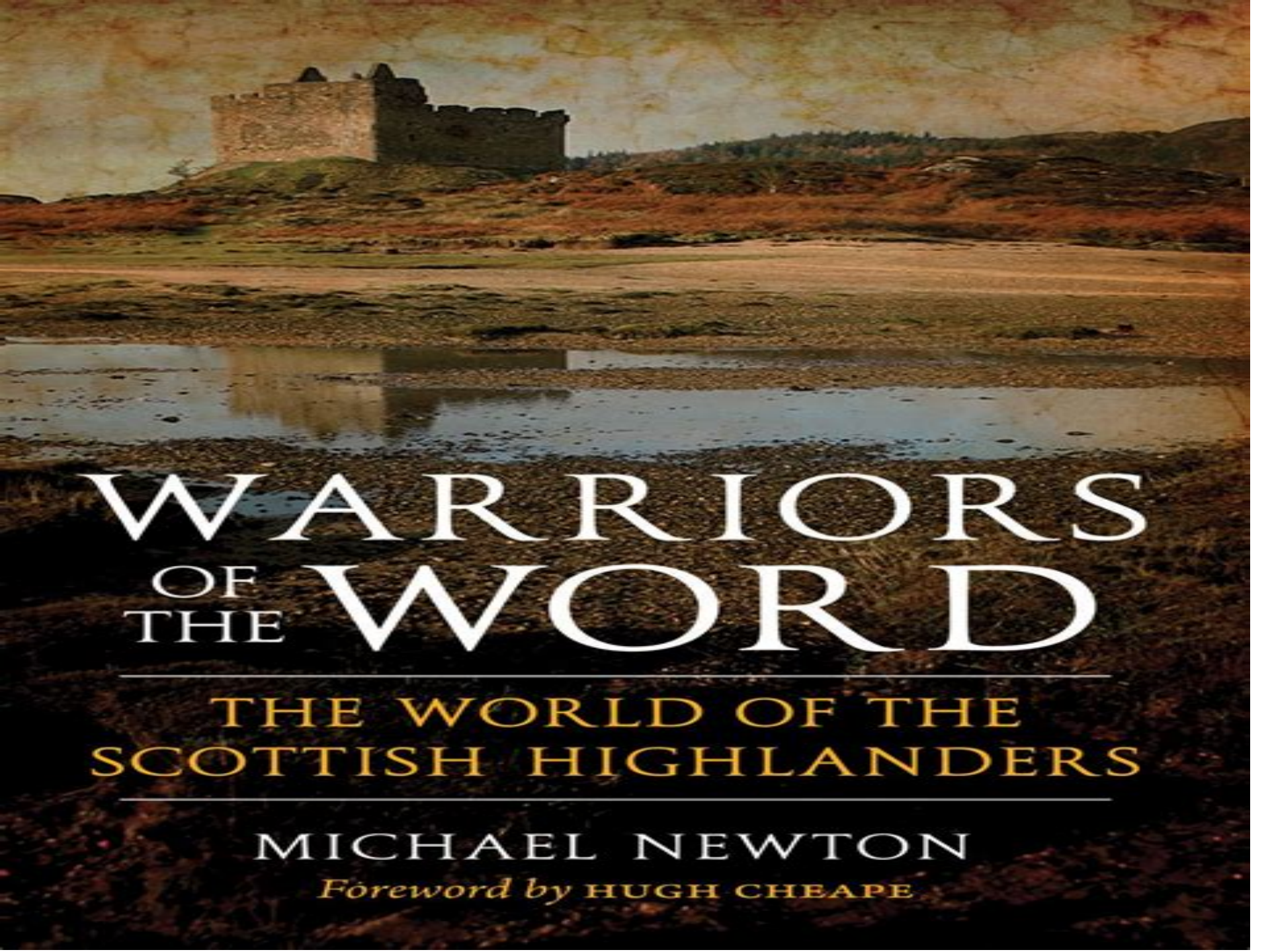

Allen, 2024 An exploration of the diverse lived experiences of marginality in Scottish society from the sixteen to the eighteenth century Throughout the early modern period Scottish society was constructed around an expectation of social conformity people were required to operate within a relatively narrow range of acceptable identities and behaviours Those who did not conform to this idealised standard or who were in some fundamental way different from the prescribed norm were met with suspicion Such individuals often attracted both criticism and discrimination forcing them to live confined to the social margins Focusing on a range of marginalised groups including the poor migrants ethnic minorities indentured workers and women the contributors to this book explore what it was like to live at the boundaries of social acceptability what mechanisms were involved in policing the divide between mainstream and marginal and what opportunities existed for personal or collective fulfilment The result is a fresh perspective on early modern Scotland one that not only recovers the stories of people long excluded from historical discussion but also offers a deeper understanding of the ordering assumptions of society more generally Specific topics addressed range from the marginalisation of people with disabilities in the domestic sphere to female sex workers and the place of executioners in society

new book re examines that fateful chain of events in 1940 and reassesses some of the myths that have grown up in the intervening years Two of the main contributors to this collection of soldiers reminiscences Angus Campbell from Lewis and Donald John MacDonald from South Uist were both traditional Gaelic bards Their work has been translated from their native language and reflects both the richness of the vocabulary they had acquired through the Gaelic oral tradition and their individual gifts as natural story tellers born out of that tradition These vivid accounts bring alive the chaos and horror of war and the grim deprivation of the camps and forced marches which so many endured Yet the personal stories also resound with the spirit humour and sense of comradeship which enabled men to fight on in desperate situations and refuse to be cowed by their captors

The Truth About St. Kilda Donald Gillies, 2017-07-05 The Truth about St Kilda is a unique record of the isolated way of life on St Kilda in the early part of the twentieth century based on seven handwritten notebooks written by the Rev Donald Gillies containing reminiscences of his childhood on the island of Hirta It provides a first hand account of the living conditions social structure and economy of the community in the early 1900s before the evacuation of the remaining residents in 1930 The memoirs describe in some detail the St Kildans way of life including religious life and the islanders diet The puritanical form of religion practised on St Kilda has often been interpreted by outsiders as austere and draconian but Gillies account of the islanders religious practices makes clear the important role that these had in reinforcing the spiritual stamina of the community This book is a lasting tribute to the adaptability and courage of a small Gaelic speaking society which endured through two millennia on a remote cluster of islands until its way of life could no longer be sustained

Island Going Robert Atkinson, 2017-07-05 In July 1935 Robert Atkinson and John Ainslie set out on an ornithological search for the rare Leach s Fork tailed Petrel Their quest was to last for twelve years and took them from their Oxford base to many of the remote and often deserted islands off the north west coast of Scotland Island Going is the account of their adventure Not only is it packed with marvellous descriptions of the wildlife and landscapes of the islands as well as the journey itself it also paints a vivid portrait of the way of life of the islanders and their history and traditions

The Guga Hunters Donald S. Murray, 2018-05-10 Every year ten men from Ness at the northern tip of the Isle of Lewis sail north east for some forty miles to a remote rock called Sulasgeir Their mission is to catch and harvest the guga the almost fully grown gannet chicks nesting on the two hundred foot high cliffs that circle the tiny island which is barely half a mile long After spending a fortnight in the arduous conditions that often prevail there they return home with around two thousand of the birds pickled and salted and ready for the tables of Nessmen and women both at home and abroad The Guga Hunters tells the story of the men who voyage to Sulasgeir each year and the district they hail from bringing out the full colour of their lives the humour and drama of their exploits They speak of the laughter that seasons their time together on Sulasgeir of the risks and dangers they have faced It also provides a fascinating insight into the social history of Ness the culture and way of life that lies behind the world of the Guga Hunters the timeless nature of the hunt and reveals the hunt s connections to the
