sound of the guns Why did Grouchy appear to move so slowly when speed was essential This is a subject which is generally overlooked by British historians who tend to concentrate on the actions of Wellington and Napoleon and which French historians choose not to look at too closely for fear that it might reflect badly upon their hero Napoleon Despite the mass of books written on Waterloo this is a genuinely unique contribution to this most famous campaign This book is certain to fuel debate and prompt historians to reconsider the events of June 1815

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
