Zero, 1958-1968 Stephan von Wiese, 2004 Palazzo delle Papesse Contemporary Art Centre presents a major exhibition showcasing the German movement Zero Group and the origins of kinetic art in Italy opening on May 29th The selection of works on display covers the period
