Japanese War Crimes during World War II Frank Jacob, 2018-06-08 A challenging examination of Japanese war crimes during World War II offers a fresh perspective on the Pacific War and a better understanding of reasons for the wartime use of extreme mass violence The 1937 Rape of Nanjing has become a symbol of Japanese violence during the Second World War but it was not the only event during which the Japanese used extreme force This thought provoking book analyzes Japan s actions during the war without blaming Japan helping readers understand what led to those eruptions In fact the author specifically disputes the idea that the forms of extreme violence used in the Pacific War were particularly Japanese The volume starts by examining the Rape of Nanjing then goes on to address Japan s acts of individual and collective violence throughout the conflict Unlike other works on the subject it combines historical sociological and psychological perspectives on violence with a specific study of the Japanese army seeking to define the reasons for the use of extreme violence in each particular case Both a historical survey and an explanation of Japanese warfare the book scrutinizes incidents of violence perpetrated by the Japanese vis vis theories that explore the use of violence as part of human nature In doing so it provides far reaching insights into the use of collective violence and torture in war overall as well as motivations for committing atrocities Finally the author discusses current political implications stemming from Japan s continued refusal to acknowledge its war time actions as war crimes

Hidden Horrors Yuki Tanaka, 2019-03-13 This book documents for the first time previously hidden Japanese atrocities in World War II including cannibalism the slaughter and starvation of prisoners of war the rape enforced prostitution and murder of noncombatants and biological warfare experiments The author describes how desperate Japanese soldiers consumed the flesh of their own comrades killed in fighting as well as that of Australians Pakistanis and Indians Another chapter traces the fate of 65 shipwrecked Australian nurses and British soldiers who were shot or stabbed to death by Japanese soldiers Thirty two other nurses who landed on another island were captured and sent to Sumatra to become comfort women prostitutes for Japanese soldiers Tanaka recounts how thousands of Australian and British POWs died in the infamous Sandakan camp in the Borneo jungle in 1945 Those who survived were forced to endure a tortuous 160 mile march on which anyone who dropped out of line was immediately shot Only six escapees lived to tell the tale Based on exhaustive research in previously closed archives this book represents a landmark analysis of Japanese war crimes The author explores individual atrocities in their broader social psychological and institutional milieu and places Japanese behavior during the war in the broader context of the dehumanization of men at war without denying individual and national responsibility

Imperial Japan's World War Two Werner Gruhl, 2017-07-12 Gruhl s

narrative makes clear why Japan's World War II aggression still touches deep emotions with East Asians and Western ex-prisoners of war and why there is justifiable sensitivity to the way modern Japan has dealt with this legacy. Knowledge of the enormity of Japan's total war is also necessary to assess the United States and her allies' policies toward Japan and their reactions to its actions extending from Manchuria in 1931 to Hiroshima in 1945. Gruhl takes the view that World War II started in 1931 when Japan, crowded and poor in raw materials but with a sense of military invincibility, saw empire as her salvation and invaded China. Japan's imperial regime had volatile ambitions but limited resources, thus encouraging them to unleash a particularly brutal offensive against the peoples of Asia and surrounding ocean islands. Their 1931 to 1945 invasions and policies further added to Asia's pre-war woes, particularly in China, by badly disrupting marginal economies, leading to famines and epidemics. Altogether, the victims of Japan's World War Two aggression took many forms and were massive in number. Gruhl offers a survey and synthesis of the historical literature and documentation, statistical data as well as personal interviews and first-hand accounts to provide a comprehensive overview and analysis. The sequence of diplomatic and military events leading to Pearl Harbor as well as those leading to the U.S. decision to drop the atom bomb are explored here as well as Japan's war crimes and postwar revisionist/apologist views regarding them. This book will be of intense interest to Asian specialists and those concerned with human rights issues in a historical context.

Judgment at Tokyo Timothy P. Maga, 2001. In the years since the Japanese war crimes trials concluded, the proceedings have been colored by charges of racism, vengeance, and guilt. In this book, Tim Maga contends that in the trials, good law was practiced and evil did not go unpunished. The defendants ranged from lowly Japanese Imperial Army privates to former prime ministers. Since they did not represent a government for which genocide was a policy pursuit, their cases were more difficult to prosecute than those of Nazi war criminals. In contrast to Nuremberg, the efforts in Tokyo, Guam, and other locations throughout the Pacific received little attention by the Western press. Once the Cold War began, America needed Pacific allies, and the atrocities committed by Japanese soldiers throughout the 1930s and early 1940s were rarely mentioned. The trials were described as phony justice and Japan bashing. Keenan and his compatriots adopted criminal court tactics and established precedents in the conduct of war crimes trials that still stand today. Maga reviews the context for the trials, recounts the proceedings, and concludes that they were, in fact, decent examples of American justice and fair play.

and implicate the highest levels of Japanese government and society in the crimes These issues led concerned parties to investigate Japanese wartime records among the holdings at the U S National Archives and Records Administration NARA in College Park Maryland and at other U S government agencies Thorough documentation of Japanese war crimes and criminal activities among these holdings seemed unavailable leading to speculation of an official cover up Suspicions that the U S government was deliberately concealing dark secrets were fueled when instead of finding the records they sought researchers encountered a card stating the records had been withdrawn for security reasons as well as when they received a notice that requested information could not be located
