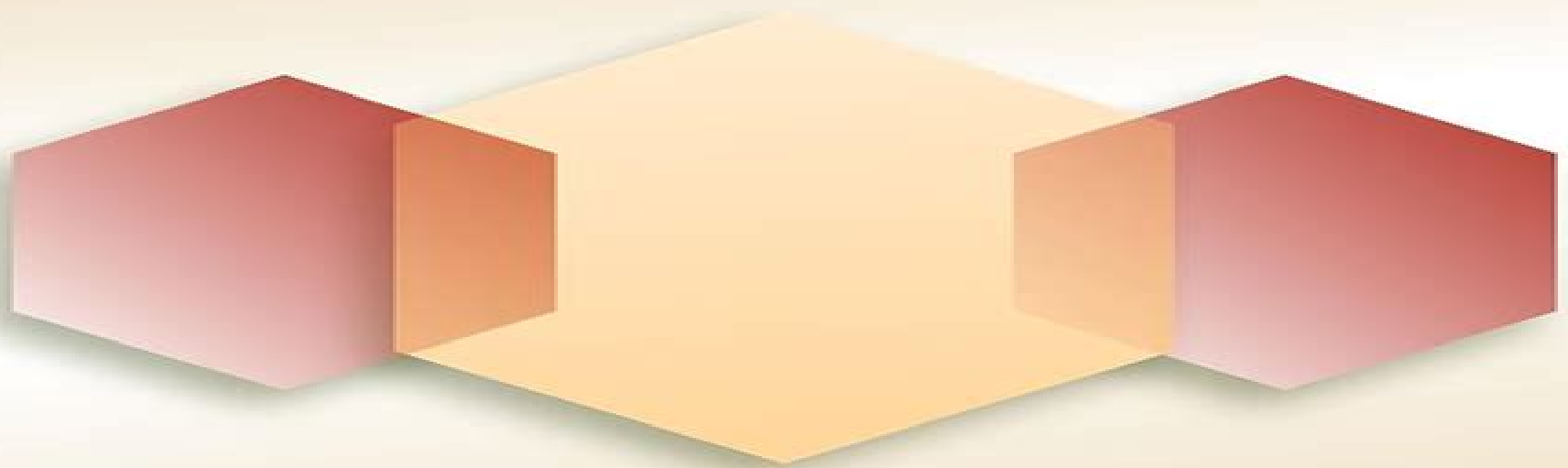

valuable new insight into Barth's view of analogy but also provides a much needed foundation for a distinctively Protestant and post-Barthian approach to theological aesthetics

Jesus, History, and Revelation Mitchell D. Mallery, 2025-07-22

There is a long standing assumption that the theological visions of Karl Barth and N T Wright are fundamentally at odds with one another with the thinkers purportedly representing two vastly different schools of thought within the Christian tradition. Jesus History and Revelation intervenes in these debates challenging the prevailing paradigm in which Barth is hailed as the forerunner of apocalyptic theology and Wright is the standard bearer of a salvation historical scheme. Mitchell Mallery demonstrates how Barth and Wright share remarkable affinities with one another in relation to Jesus as the objective historical reality of revelation, the subjective conditions for the possibility of human reception of revelation, and the task of the historian. Jesus History and Revelation proposes that the lived history of Jesus and the reality of divine revelation cannot be neatly categorized into apocalyptic or salvation historical schemes. Indeed, whereas those debates often center on Pauline interpretation, Mallery suggests that these issues first require to be addressed in relation to the historical Jesus, the Gospels, and Christology proper. Jesus History and Revelation is the first book to bring the work of Karl Barth into dialogue with N T Wright. Importantly, Mallery clarifies the relationship between the creaturely form of Jesus's humanity and the content of divine revelation, explains the necessary conditions whereby humans can discern this revelation, and unpacks the implications of both for a proper understanding of the relevance and limits of historical study for Christian theology.

Christology and the Theological Interpretation of the New Testament Thomas H. McCall, 2021-03-04 This study draws upon the resources of both contemporary analytic theology and the theological interpretation of the New Testament in order to investigate a set of important issues in Christology. It is the first work in analytic Christology to draw upon both recent scholarship in biblical studies and recent contributions to analytic philosophy and theology. Thomas H. McCall explores the themes of union with Christ and the faith of Christ as these are developed by the apocalyptic and New Perspective interpreters of Pauline theology. The volume offers a careful analysis of recent dogmatic proposals about the identity of Christ and the doctrine of election and provides an examination of debates over the subordination of the Son in Hebrews. It also probes the relationship of the incarnate Son to his Father in Johannine theology. McCall presents an exegetically grounded theological engagement with recent work on the place of logic in the doctrine of the incarnation.

Freedom, Necessity,

and the Knowledge of God Paul D. Molnar, 2021-12-30 Paul D. Molnar discusses issues related to the concepts of freedom and necessity in trinitarian doctrine. He considers the implications of non-conceptual knowledge of God by comparing the approaches of Karl Rahner and T. F. Torrance. He also reconsiders T. F. Torrance's new natural theology and illustrates why Christology must be central when discussing liberation theology. Further, he explores Catholic and Protestant relations by comparing the views of Elizabeth Johnson, Walter Kasper, and Karl Barth, as well as relations among Christians, Jews, and Muslims by considering whether it is appropriate to claim that all three religions should be understood to be united under

the concept of monotheism Finally he probes the controversial issues of how to name God in a way that underscores the full equality of women and men and how to understand universalism by placing Torrance and David Bentley Hart into conversation on that subject

resource for unsettling and reimagining the heteropatriarchal structure of human fellowship at the heart of his theological anthropology Moving through Barth's doctrines of revelation creation theological anthropology and special ethics Faye Bodley Dangelo locates the human agent in his broader project aimed at rehabilitating the subject of modern protestant theology She argues the human actor comes into view as the recipient of Christ's redemptive activity which redirects it out of self aggrandizing isolation and into relationships of dependency responsiveness and ethical responsibility to multiple sites of divine and creaturely alterity The book debates that Barth's model of human agency cannot on its own terms sustain his version of female subordination nor his repudiation of same sex relationships Rather it contains ethically oriented critical and reflective mechanisms that resist the sexist heterosexist dimension of his theological anthropology and lend themselves to an anti essentialist performative account of gender
