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Towards Professional Wisdom Cecelia Clegg, 2016-02-24 People professions such as social work teaching nursing ministry and counselling are at heart ethical or moral enterprises Much recent theorizing has been concerned to show that effective professional deliberation and judgement cannot be reduced either to technical rationality or to simple obedience to general occupational procedures or prescriptions Professional judgement would seem to require the development of a distinctive mode of practical ethical reflection or wisdom perhaps along the lines of Aristotle's phronesis or practical wisdom Reflection is required to address such key professional concerns as What is the impact of official prescription and regulation on professional judgement How should conflicts of
