Their dire status encouraged the adoption of a ban on hunting and a treaty that formed the International Whaling Commission. Recovery of the species however has proven elusive. Ship strikes and entanglement in commercial fishing gear have hampered Herculean efforts to restore the population. Today only about 500 right whales live along the US and Canadian Atlantic coasts an improvement from the early twentieth century but still a far cry from the thousands that once graced Atlantic waters. Laist's masterpiece features an incredible collection of photographs and artwork that give life to the fascinating history that unfolds in its pages. The result is a single volume that offers a comprehensive understanding of North Atlantic right whales the role they played in the many cultures that hunted them and our modern attempts to help them recover.
