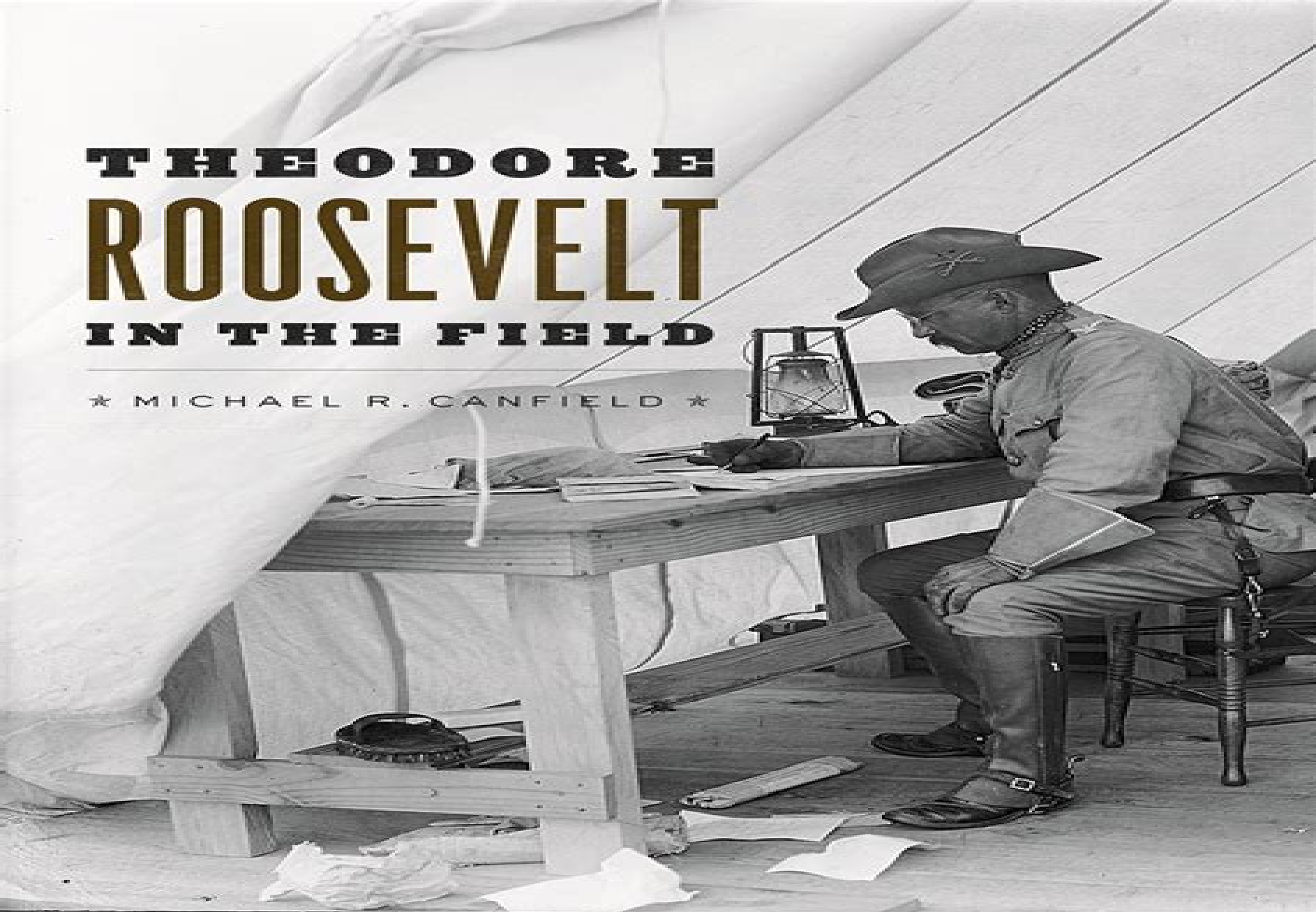

When we picture him, he is on horseback or standing at a cliff's edge or dressed for safari. And Roosevelt was more than just an adventurer; he was also a naturalist and campaigner for conservation. His love of the outdoor world began at an early age and was driven by a need not to simply observe nature but to be actively involved in the outdoors, to be in the field. As Michael R. Throughout, we see how the seemingly contradictory aspects of Roosevelt's biography as a hunter and a naturalist are actually complementary traits of a man eager to directly understand and experience the environment around him.
