Whaling in Japan Jun Morikawa, 2009 For years the Japanese government the Institute of Cetacean Research in Tokyo and environmental activists have engaged in a bitter battle over the future of Japan's whaling industry Proponents of the practice hope to control the debate by limiting the argument to the preservation of Japan's whaling traditions and whale eating culture through sustainable use but as Jun Morikawa makes clear these terms obscure the true complexity of the issue Offering a broader and more objective analytical framework Morikawa investigates the political actors and forces that create control and implement Japan's policy and continue to shape debate Pro whalers Morikawa finds have largely prevailed by spinning political myths manipulating public opinion and exploiting antiwhaling activities to their own advantage Their efforts have created a domestic consensus that allows Tokyo's whaling policies to continue relatively unchallenged despite stockpiles of whale meat that remain unsold in Japanese warehouses Focusing on the gap between political fiction and environmental reality Morikawa highlights rarely discussed aspects of the decision making process in relation to this issue and examines how diplomacy and aid have helped Japan secure support for its whaling policies internationally He also evaluates the long term future of whaling especially in light of growing environmental consciousness Norm Antipreneurs and the Politics of Resistance to Global Normative Change Alan Bloomfield, Shirley V.
