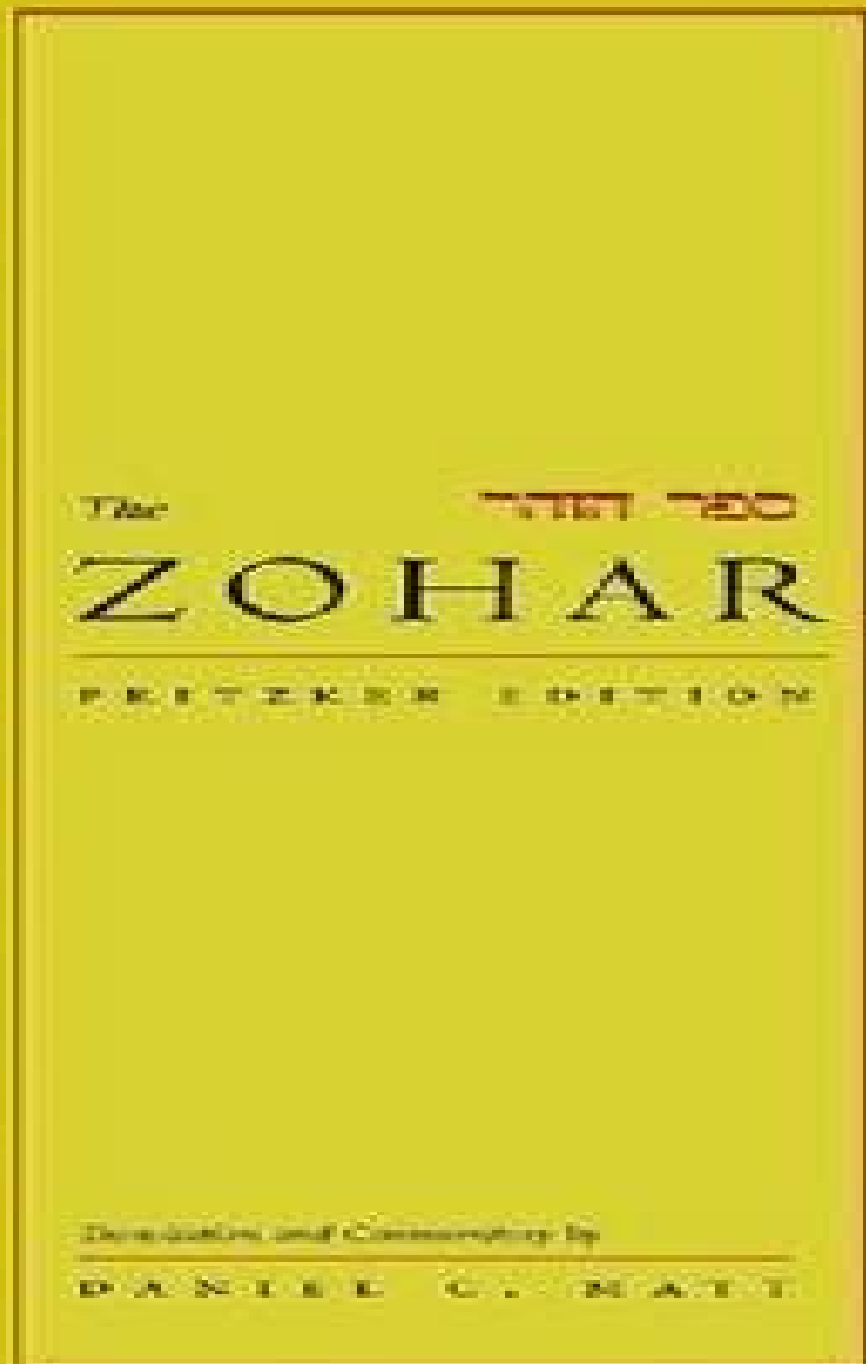

The Roots of Jewish Consciousness, Volume Two Erich Neumann, 2019-04-24 The Roots of Jewish Consciousness Volume Two Hasidism is the second volume fully annotated of a major previously unpublished two part work by Erich Neumann 1905-1960 It was written between 1940 and 1945 after Neumann then a young philosopher and physician and freshly trained as a disciple of Jung fled Berlin to settle in Tel Aviv He finished this work at the end of World War II Although he never published it he kept it the rest of his life Volume Two Hasidism is devoted to the psychological and spiritual wisdom embodied in Jewish spiritual tradition Relying on Jung's concepts and Buber's Hasidic interpretations Neumann seeks alternatives to the legalism and anti feminine bias that he says have dominated collective Judaism since the Second Temple He argues that modern Jews can develop psychological wholeness through an appropriation of Hasidic legends Talmudic texts and Kabbalistic mysteries including especially the Zohar Exclusively this volume includes a foreword by Moshe Idel An appendix Neumann's four lecture series from the 1940s gives a glimpse of his intended unpublished Part Three These volumes anticipate Neumann's later works including *Depth Psychology* and *A New Ethic* The Origins and History of Consciousness and *The Great Mother* In Volume Two Hasidism his concept of the ego Self axis is developed in clearly psychological terms Four previously unpublished essays appended to Volume Two illustrate Neumann's developmental psychology including his theme of primary and secondary personalization This unique work will appeal to Jungian analysts and psychotherapists in training and in practice historians of psychology Jewish scholars biblical historians teachers of comparative religion as well as academics

Deuteronomy This sixth volume of The Zohar Pritzker Edition completes the Zohar's commentary on the book of Exodus Some of the volume focuses on the Dwelling or mishkan built by Moses and the Israelites in the Sinai Desert The mishkan symbolizes Shekhinah the feminine presence of God who dwells on earth The construction of the mishkan is intended to ensure Her intimacy with the people and especially with Moses who is actually called Her husband The dramatic episode of the Golden Calf receives special treatment The worship of the calf is seen as a rejection of Shekhinah Normally She would have restrained the wrath of God's masculine aspect and prevented Him from striking Israel but having been rejected She instead departed leaving the people vulnerable Whereupon the blessed Holy One hinted to Moses that it was up to him to defend Israel from divine destruction By invoking the three patriarchs Moses pinned God's arms as it were and immobilized Him saving his people With the appearance of this volume The Zohar Pritzker Edition has reached its halfway point The projected Volumes VII IX will complete the Zohar's main commentary on the Torah Volumes X XII will include the Zohar's commentary on various other books of the Bible such as Ruth and Song of Songs as well as several independent compositions
