

Threats to Psychological Research

Psychological research is often conducted in a laboratory setting, which may not be representative of the real world. This can lead to a lack of ecological validity, where the findings of the study may not be applicable to real-world situations. For example, a study on memory recall conducted in a quiet laboratory setting may not be applicable to a noisy, busy environment.

Another threat to psychological research is the use of self-report measures, such as questionnaires and surveys. These measures are often subject to social desirability bias, where participants may report behaviors or attitudes that are socially acceptable rather than their true feelings or behaviors.
