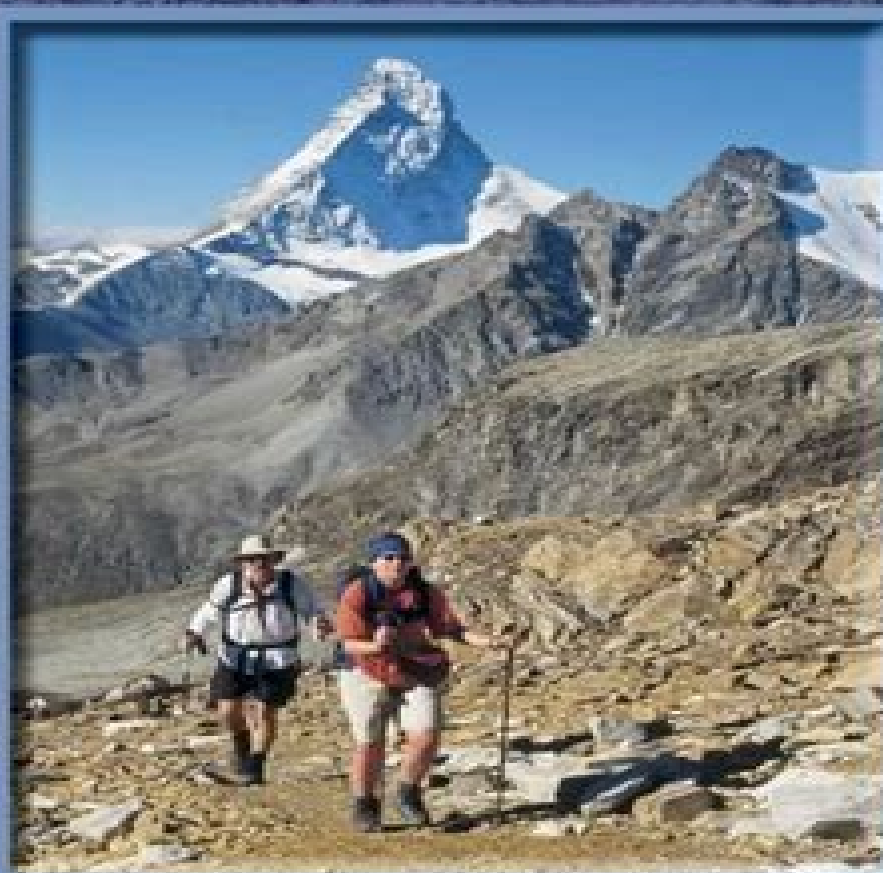

Tour of the Matterhorn Hilary Sharp, 2006 A guide to the 145km Tour of the Matterhorn described anti clockwise from Zermatt and visits 6 valleys via Zinal Arolla and Breuil offering spectacular views of 25 peaks of over 4000m The route also links up with the Chamonix to Zermatt walkers Haute Route and the Tour of Monte Rosa Includes two glacier crossings and takes 8 to 10 days *Trekking Chamonix to Zermatt* Kev Reynolds, 2024-03-19 A guidebook to the Walker s Haute Route a classic trek between Chamonix in France and Zermatt in Switzerland Covering 215km 134 miles this long distance trek linking Mont Blanc and the Matterhorn takes around 2 weeks and is suitable for trekkers with Alpine experience The route is described west to east in 14 stages each between 9 and 20km 6 12 miles in length The route takes in 11 passes and 14 000m of ascent with several route alternatives included allowing you to select the itinerary that suits you 1 50 000 mapping included for each stage GPX files available to download Detailed information on mountain huts facilities and refreshments along the route Advice on planning and preparation **The Swiss Alps** Kev Reynolds, 2014-01-08 This comprehensive book is an excellent planning resource for those who wish to venture into the Swiss Alps Whether you are planning a walk scramble climb or ski tour this larger format guide describes each mountain area throughout Switzerland the peaks passes valleys and bases to help readers identify the best destinations for their chosen mountain activity Dozens of individual valleys are described together with the mountains that wall them with recommendations given for their finest walks treks and climbs Working eastwards across the country this guide is divided into seven chapters Chablais Alps Pennine Alp Lepontine and Adula Alps Bernina Bregaglia and Albula Alps Bernese Alps Central Swiss Alps and the Silvretta and Ratikon Alps each devoted to a specific range or group of connecting ranges However this is not a route guide and detailed descriptions are not provided The aim of the book is to inspire as well as inform to show first time visitors just what the Swiss Alps have to offer and provide a new perspective for those who have been before **Trekking the Robert Louis Stevenson Trail** Nike Werstroh, Jacint Mig, 2021-02-15 Robert Louis Stevenson s Travels with a donkey in the C vennes is a classic of travel literature The GR70 long distance trail is based on the author s route allowing walkers to follow in the footsteps of Stevenson and his four legged companion Modestine through the beautiful C vennes region on the edge of France s Massif Central The route is ideal for both first time trekkers and more experienced hikers covering around 272km of gently undulating countryside from Le Puy en Velay to Al s It can be completed in under a fortnight The trail is presented in 12 stages of 16 to 30km each with clear route description and mapping an elevation profile notes on local points of interest and a brief account of Robert Louis Stevenson s experiences on that section of the route There is useful advice for planning your trip including when to go what to take and how to get there and accommodation listings Following drove roads bridleways and footpaths the GR70 showcases the landscapes of the C vennes wildflower meadows rolling hills chestnut woods limestone gorges and meandering rivers Characterful villages provide accommodation and other services and offer an opportunity to sample the

delicious local produce There are also glimpses into the region's fascinating history from pre-historic burial sites to locations associated with the eighteenth-century Protestant Camisards who resisted religious persecution While many things have undoubtedly changed since Stevenson's visit the area retains its authentic rural charm and you will soon discover just why Stevenson found it so appealing
