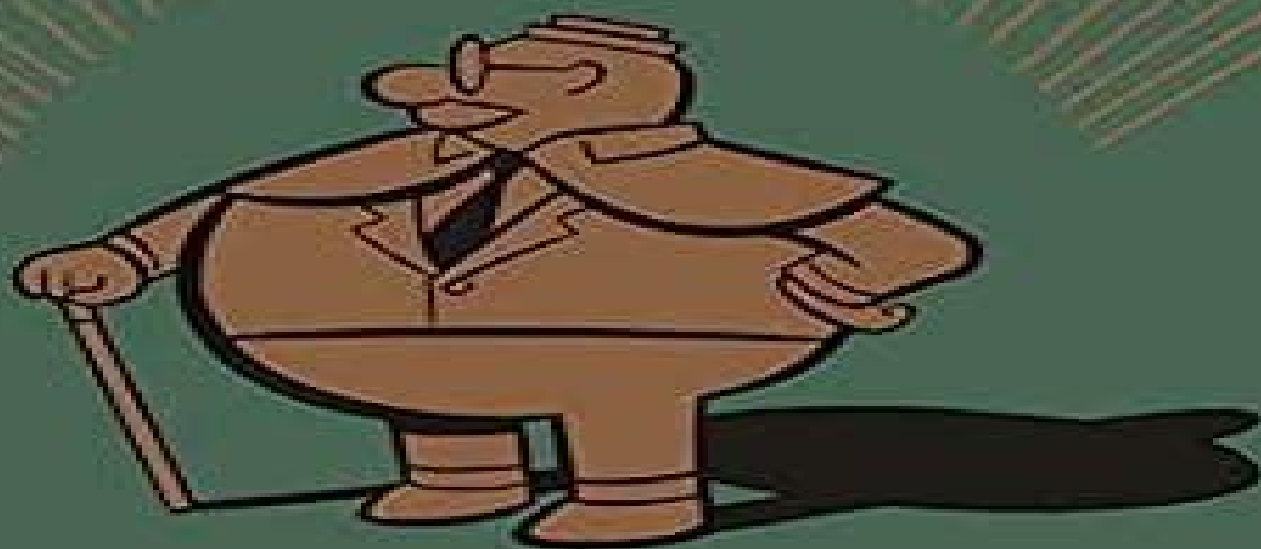

Comics and Stuff Henry Jenkins, 2020-04-14 Considers how comics display our everyday stuff junk drawers bookshelves attics as a way into understanding how we represent ourselves now For most of their history comics were widely understood as disposable you read them and discarded them and the pulp paper they were printed on decomposed over time Today comic books have been
