Serious Fun at a Jewish Community Summer Camp Celia E. Rothenberg, 2016-07-01 Unique in the literature on Jewish camping this book provides an in depth study of a community based residential summer camp that serves Jewish children from primarily rural areas Focused on Camp Ben Frankel CBF established in 1950 in southern Illinois this book focuses on how a pluralist Jewish camp constructs meaningful experiences of Jewish family and Judaism for campers and teaches them about Israel Inspired by models of the earliest camps established for Jewish children in urban areas CBF s founders worked to create a camp that would appeal to the rural often isolated Jewish families in its catchment area Although seemingly on the periphery of American Jewish life CBF staff and campers are revealed to be deeply entwined with national developments in Jewish culture and practice and indeed contributors to shaping them This research highlights the importance of campers experiences of traditional elements of the Jewish family an experience increasingly limited to time at camp as well as the overarching importance of song Over the years Judaism becomes constructed as fun welcoming and easy for campers while Israel is presented in ways that are meant to be appropriate for a community camp In the camp s earliest decades Israel was framed by traditional Zionist discourse later as community priorities shifted the cause of Russian Jews was the focus Most recently as Israeli politics have been increasingly viewed as potentially divisive the camp has adopted an Israel lite approach focusing on Israel as the Biblical homeland of the Jewish people and a place home to Jews who are similar to American Jews In sum this study sheds light on how a small rural community camp contributes in significant ways to our understanding of American Jews their Judaism and their Zionism

Furry Fandom Conventions, 1989-2015 Fred Patten, 2017-01-17 Furry fandom an adult social group interested in anthropomorphic animals in art literature and culture has grown since the 1980s to include an estimated 50 000 furries Their largest annual convention drew more than 6 000 attendees in 2015 including 1 000 dressed in fur suits or mascot type animal costumes Conventions typically include awards organizations art literature and movies encompassing a wide range of creative pursuits beyond animal costuming This study of the furry subculture presents a history of the oft misunderstood group and lists all conventions around the world from 1989 through 2015 including organizers guests of honor and donations to charity

Schools and Informal Learning in a Knowledge-Based World Javier Calvo de Mora, Kerry J. Kennedy, 2019-09-19 This book has two purposes To open up the debate on the role of informal education in schooling systems and to suggest the kind of school organizational environment that can best facilitate the recognition of informal learning Successive chapters explore what is often seen as a duality between informal and formal learning This duality is particularly so because education systems expend so much time and effort in certifying formal knowledge often expressed in school subjects reflecting academic disciplines Recognizing the contribution informal learning can make to young people s understanding and development does not negate the importance of valued social knowledge That complements it Students come to school with knowledge learnt from their families peers the community and both traditional

and social media They should not have to unlearn this in order to enter the world of formal learning Rather students different learning worlds should be integrated so that each informs the other In a knowledge based society all learning needs to be valued Some contributors to this book reflect on how new educational systems could be created in a move away from top down authoritarian and bureaucratic management Such open systems are seen to be more welcoming in acknowledging the importance of informal learning Others provide practical examples of how informal learning is currently recognized Some attention is also paid to the evaluation of informal learning A key objective of the work presented here is to stimulate debate about the role of informal learning in knowledge based societies and to stimulate thinking about the kind of reforms needed to create more open and more democratic school learning environments **Special issue on research** Colette
