Workers at the plant earned \$15.14 an hour, had good insurance, and were assured a solid retirement. In 2004, the plant was relocated to Reynosa, Mexico, where workers spent 13-hour days assembling refrigerators for \$11.10 an hour. In *Boom, Bust, Exodus*, Chad Broughton offers a ground-level look at the rapid transition to a globalized economy from the perspective of those whose lives it has most deeply affected. We live in a commoditized world increasingly divorced from the origins of the goods we consume; it is easy to ignore who is manufacturing our smart phones and hybrid cars and where they come from, no longer seems to matter.
