American lives at risk The greatest challenge for the United States now Krasner writes is to identify a set of policies that lie between the utopian vision that all countries can be like the United States and the dystopian view that nothing can be done He prescribes a pragmatic new course of policy Drawing on decades of research he makes the case for good enough governance governance that aims for better security better health limited economic growth and some protection of human rights To this end Krasner proposes working with despots to promote growth In a world where a single terrorist can kill thousands or even hundreds of thousands of people the United States does not have the luxury of idealistically ignoring the rest of the world But it cannot remake the world in its own image either Instead it must learn how to make love to despots
