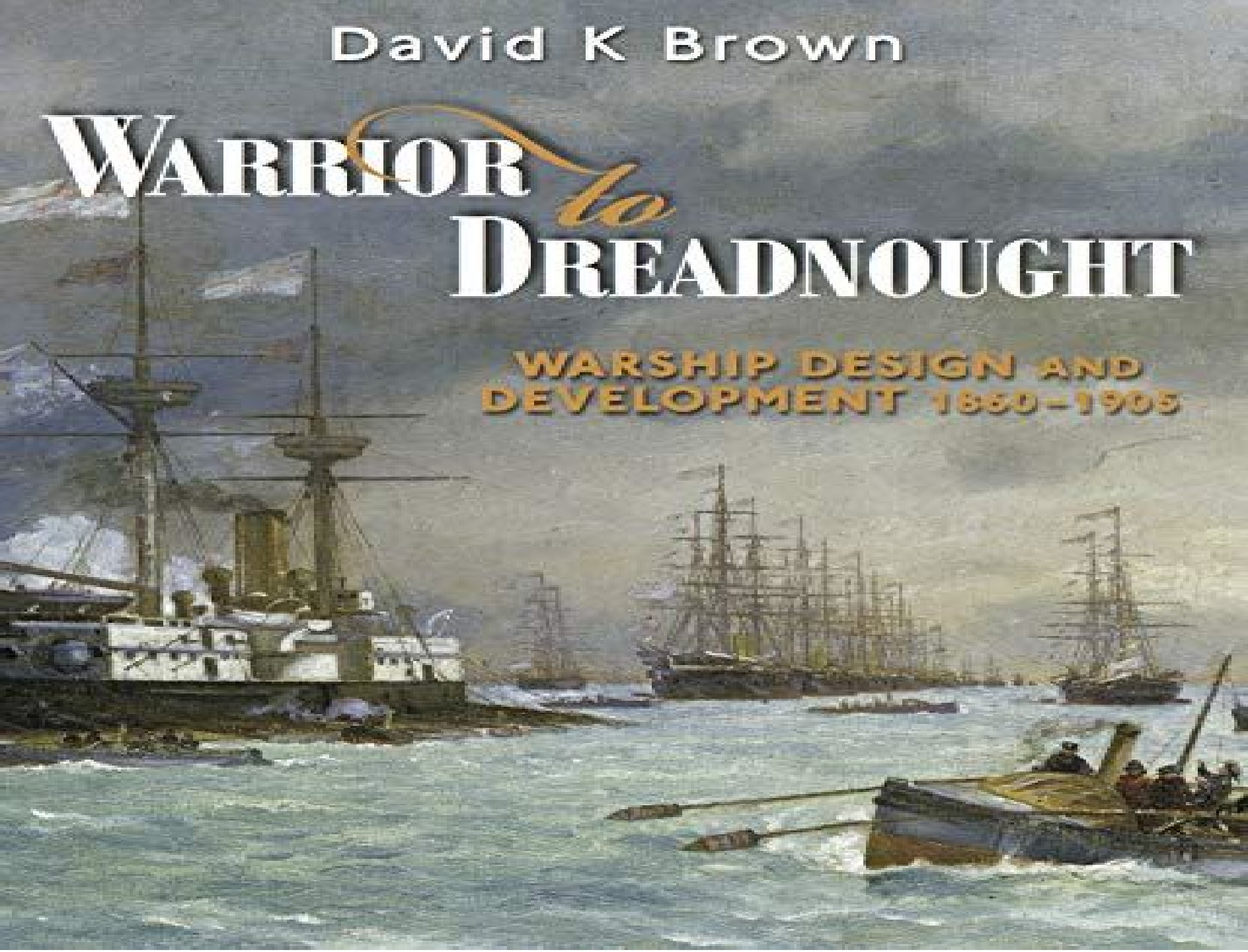

Warrior to Dreadnought David K Brown, 2010-09-22 In the 50 years that separated Warrior from Dreadnought there occurred a revolution in warship design quite unparalleled in naval history a period that began with the fully rigged broadside ironclads and ended with the emergence of the great battleships and battlecruisers that were to fight in the First World War The author explains how nineteenth century designers responded to developments in engine technology armour protection and armament in their attempts to develop the best possible fighting ships He details the development of more efficient engines that brought about the demise of the sailing warship and the competition between armour and armament with every increase in the power of guns stimulating the development of ever more sophisticated methods of protection Importantly he explains that the Victorian Royal Navy far from being the reactionary body it is so often depicted as was in fact at the forefront of technological change for example in the employment of torpedoes and the development of countermeasures to them Full accounts are given of the significant naval events and battles of the period making the book a fine narrative history as well as a brilliant work of warship reference D K BROWN was a distinguished naval architect who retired in 1988 as Deputy Chief Naval Architect of the Royal Corps of Naval Constructors He published widely on the subject of warship design and built a reputation as a clear and brilliant commentator on the development of the ships of the Royal Navy He died in 2008

Victorian Era Norman Friedman, 2012-10-29 This magnificent book reinforces Norman Friedman's unparalleled reputation as a peerless author of maritime topics Australian Naval Institute Gradually evolving from the masted steam frigates of the mid nineteenth century the first modern cruiser is not easy to define but for the sake of this book historian Norman Friedman takes as a starting point *Iris* and *Mercury* of 1875 They were the Royal Navy's first steel built warships were designed primarily to be steamed rather than sailed and formed the basis of a line of succeeding cruiser classes The story progresses with the last armored cruisers which were succeeded by the first battlecruisers originally called armored cruisers and with the last Third Class Cruisers *Topaze* class all conceived before 1906 While dovetailing precisely with the author's previous book on British cruisers this one also includes the wartime experience of the earlier ships The two central themes are cruisers for the fleet and cruisers for overseas operations including but not limited to trade protection The distant waters aspect covers the belted cruisers which were nearly capital ships intended to deal with foreign second class battleships in the Far East The main enemies contemplated during this period were France and Russia and the book includes British assessments of their strength and intentions with judgments as to how accurate those assessments were Deeply researched original in its analysis and full of striking insights this is another major contribution by Norman Friedman to the history of British warships *Brown-, Green- and Blue-Water Fleets* Michael Lindberg, Daniel Todd, 2001-11-30 From riverine operations in the American Civil War and China in the 1860s to the major fleet engagements of the World Wars plus more recent naval actions in the Falklands Malvenas War and Gulf War Lindberg and Todd methodically show how geography has shaped the strategy tactics and tools of naval warfare Alfred T Mahan was perhaps the first naval professional to recognize and acknowledge fully the influence of geography on navies and naval warfare Many of his principles of seapower were inherently geographical and influenced both what kind of naval force a state would possess and how it would be utilized In the time that has passed since Mahan made his observations naval warfare and navies have experienced major technological changes yet geographical factors continue to exert their influence on how navies fight how they are structured and the design of the ships that they deploy After providing a comprehensive review of geostrategic theory and its application to

Genesis of the Grand Fleet Christopher Buckey, 2021-05-15 Genesis of the Grand Fleet The Admiralty Germany and the Home Fleet 1896 1914 tells the story of the prewar predecessor to the Royal Navy's war winning Grand Fleet the Home Fleet Established in early 1907 by First Sea Lord Sir John Fisher the Home Fleet combined an active core of powerful armored warships with a unification of the various reserve divisions of warships previously under the control of the three Royal Navy home port commands Fisher boasted that the new Home Fleet would be able to counter the growing German Hochseeflotte While these boasts were accurate they were not the sole motivation behind the Home Fleet's establishment The Liberal Party's landslide victory in the 1906 General Election made fiscal economy on the part of the Admiralty even more important than before and this significantly influenced the Home Fleet's creation Subsequently the Home Fleet suffered a sustained campaign of criticism by the commander in chief of the Channel Fleet Lord Charles Beresford This campaign ruined many careers including Beresford's and resulted in the assimilation of the Channel Fleet into the Home Fleet in 1909 From 1910 onward the Home Fleet steadily evolved and became the most important single command in the Royal Navy and the Home Fleet's successive commanders in chief had influence on strategic policy rivaled only by the Board of Admiralty The last prewar commander of the Home Fleet Admiral Sir George Callaghan achieved this influence by impressing the civilian head of the Admiralty Winston Churchill A driven reformer Churchill's influence was almost as important as Fisher's Against this backdrop of political drama Genesis of the Grand Fleet The Admiralty Germany and the Home Fleet 1896 1914 explains how Britain maintained its maritime preeminence in the early twentieth century As Christopher Buckey describes the fleet sustained Britain and her allies path to victory in World War I
