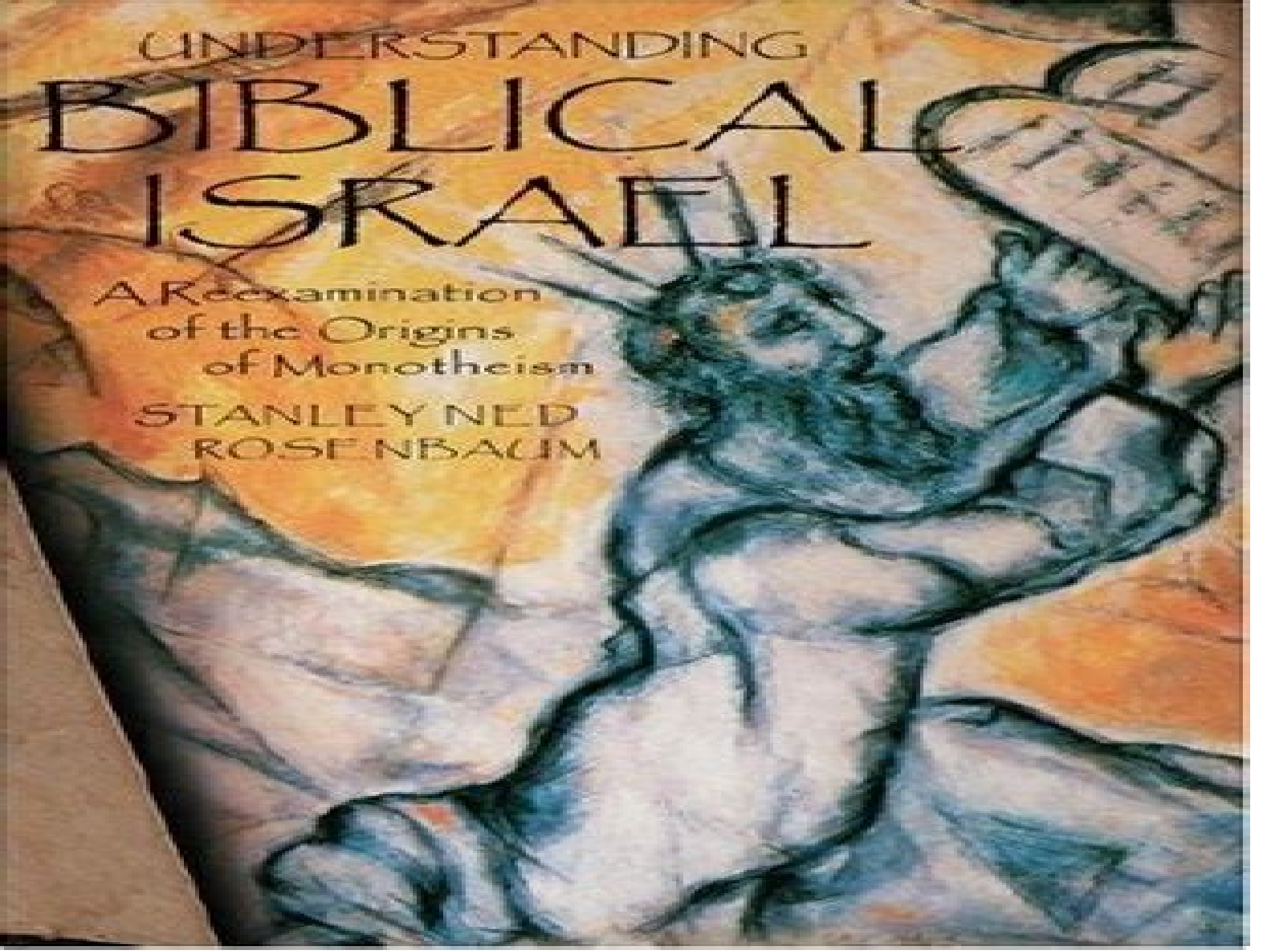

Understanding Biblical Israel Stanley Ned Rosenbaum, 2002 According to Stanley Rosenbaum the Bible resembles what a family would retrieve after a tornado hits a trailer park some of the family's own possessions mixed with those of others overlapping contradicting and disordered Understanding Israelite History is a revolutionary attempt to fill in the many gaps left in the historical record Rosenbaum begins by demonstrating that Israel's religion was not a clean divinely inspired break with humanity's past but derives from the long sweep of events that began when Homo sapiens first acquired language Strata of earlier religions are still visible beneath the surface of Israelite monotheism Early Israel was not one man's family however dysfunctional It was a collection of individuals and groups mainly outcasts or lower social elements who coalesced into a nation and developed though they did not always follow a religion of ethical monotheism and principles of democratic government and social justice that still today move and inspire more than half the world's population Like all religions Israel's was shaped by the language in this case Hebrew in which it is expressed Expressing monotheism in a language that is essentially dualistic conduced to the suppression of the female elements of earlier religions which had nurtured Israel's religion and consequently to a lack of appreciation for the part played by women in Israel's religious life This skewed view of Israel's religion and its history that the Bible contains is a result of its having been collected edited and in part written by Judeans southern survivors and heirs of David's kingdom who were moved to record it in the wake of the destruction of Jerusalem in 586 BCE

H. van Wijk-Bos, 2005-09-14 Too long restricted to children's storybooks and cinematic extravaganzas the Torah comprising the first five books of the Bible is an underappreciated mother lode of divine instruction vitally important for Christians and the church Convinced that both those who take the Torah too literally and those who neglect it are guilty of a naive simplicity Johanna van Wijk Bos presents guidelines to help ordinary Christians recover this treasure in their faith and practice Having lived in the Netherlands during the Nazi occupation van Wijk Bos recognizes that after the attempted annihilation of the Jews from Christian Europe it cannot be business as usual for Christianity In light of the Holocaust Christians must commit themselves to the restoration of just relations between Christians and Jews This commitment to address all that fractures human relations undergirds van Wijk Bos's call for Christians to reengage the Torah Making Wise the Simple points out how God's care for and engagement with the whole world in the Torah set the tone for the entire biblical story The book pays special attention to how our treatment of strangers lies at the heart of the Torah's teaching Without attempting a purely Jewish reading of the Torah van Wijk Bos reclaims the Torah as a vibrant word for the Christian community in covenant with God Written in a personal style conversant with current scholarship but sprinkled with anecdotes this book is for everyone who has a hunger and enthusiasm for what the biblical text may convey the courage to ask disturbing questions of the text and an openness to old words that may bring forth new things perhaps even making one wise

Măcelaru, 2012-10-01 This book explores the expression of Israelite identity in the Hebrew Bible in the so called Deuteronomistic History The study shows that instances of direct discourse that employ identity related language placed within narrative contexts that epitomize episodes of status change in the development of Israel s narrated life constitute a narrative technique used to depict Israel s identity Being placed in contexts that suggest ritualistic performance and being articulated in the interaction of a triad of characters consisting of YHWH Israel and Israel s Leader s these discourses are exemplary instances of performative language Their examination from this perspective reveals a developing theological motif of gradual divine human distancing intrinsic to how Israel s identity is expressed in the Hebrew Bible

First Isaiah and the Disappearance of the Gods Matthew J. Lynch, 2021-05-10 Isaiah 1 39 uses the unique term usually translated as idols more than anywhere else in the Hebrew Bible Using this linguistic phenomenon as a point of departure Matthew J Lynch reexamines the rhetorical strategies of First Isaiah revealing a stronger monotheizing rhetoric than previously recognized Standard accounts of Israelite religion frequently insist that monotheism reached its apex during the exile and especially in Deutero Isaiah By contrast Lynch s study brings to light an equally potent mode of monotheizing in First Isaiah Lynch identifies three related rhetorical tendencies that emphasize yhwh s supreme uniqueness a rhetoric of avoidance referring to other deities as idols to avoid conferring on them the status of gods a rhetoric of exaltation emphasizing yhwh s truly exalted status in opposition to all that which exalted itself and a rhetoric of abasement fully subjugating all other claimants to absolute power whether human or divine before the divine king Succinctly and persuasively argued Lynch s book will change how biblical scholars understand the nature and development of Israelite monotheism

Iesus Deus M. David Litwa, 2014 What does it mean for Jesus to be deified in early Christian literature Early

Christians did not simply assert Jesus divinity in their literature they depicted Jesus with the specific and widely recognized traits of Mediterranean deities Relying on the methods of the history of religions and ranging judiciously across Hellenistic literature M David Litwa shows that at each stage in their depiction of Jesus life and ministry early Christian writings from the beginning relied on categories drawn not from Judaism alone but on a wide pan Mediterranean understanding of deity

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
