EMPLOYEE RIGHTS UNDER THE FAMILY AND MEDICAL LEAVE ACT

What is the FMLA? The FMLA is a federal law that gives eligible employees the right to take unpaid, job-protected leave for certain family and medical reasons. During the leave, your employer must maintain your position or an equivalent position for you.

Who is covered by the FMLA? The FMLA covers federal government employees and private-sector employers with 50 or more employees who work at the same location for at least 75 days in a year. Employees must have worked for the employer for at least one year to be eligible for FMLA leave.

What are the FMLA leave reasons? FMLA leave is available for the following reasons:

- The birth, adoption, or placement of a child.
- The care of a child, spouse, or parent with a serious health condition.
- The care of the employee's own serious health condition.
- The death of a child, spouse, or parent.
- The employee's own serious health condition that makes the employee unable to perform his or her job.

How much FMLA leave can I take? Eligible employees are entitled to 12 workweeks of FMLA leave in a 12-month period. Some employers may require employees to use their paid vacation or sick leave during FMLA leave.

What are the FMLA leave procedures? Employees must provide their employer with advance notice of their FMLA leave. Employees must also provide their employer with medical certification of their FMLA leave.

What are the FMLA leave consequences? If an employer violates the FMLA, the employer may be liable for damages, including back pay, benefits, and reinstatement.

YOUR RIGHTS UNDER USERRA THE UNEMPLOYED SERVICE EMPLOYMENT AND REEMPLOYMENT RIGHTS ACT

What is USERRA? USERRA is a federal law that protects the rights of employees who are called to active military service. USERRA requires employers to reemploy service members who have been called to active military service and to provide them with the same benefits and seniority as if they had not been called to active military service.

Who is covered by USERRA? USERRA covers federal government employees and private-sector employers with 100 or more employees who work at the same location for at least 1 year.

What are the USERRA leave reasons? USERRA leave is available for the following reasons:

- The employee's call to active military service.
- The employee's call to active military service as a reservist.
- The employee's call to active military service as a member of the National Guard.

How much USERRA leave can I take? Employees are entitled to 5 years of USERRA leave. Some employers may require employees to use their paid vacation or sick leave during USERRA leave.

What are the USERRA leave procedures? Employees must provide their employer with advance notice of their USERRA leave. Employees must also provide their employer with a copy of their military orders.

What are the USERRA leave consequences? If an employer violates USERRA, the employer may be liable for damages, including back pay, benefits, and reinstatement.

EMPLOYEE RIGHTS UNDER THE FAIR LABOR STANDARDS ACT

FEDERAL MINIMUM WAGE

What is the FLSA? The FLSA is a federal law that sets the minimum wage, overtime pay, and other labor standards for most workers in the United States.

Who is covered by the FLSA? The FLSA covers federal government employees and private-sector employers with 50 or more employees who work at the same location for at least 75 days in a year.

What are the FLSA minimum wage and overtime pay requirements? The FLSA requires employers to pay their employees at least the federal minimum wage of \$7.25 per hour. Employers must also pay their employees overtime pay at a rate of at least 1.5 times the employee's regular rate of pay for hours worked in excess of 40 hours per week.

What are the FLSA minimum wage and overtime pay exceptions? The FLSA has several exceptions to its minimum wage and overtime pay requirements, including for certain agricultural workers, domestic workers, and independent contractors.

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EMPLOYEE RIGHTS EMPLOYEE POLYGRAPH PROTECTION ACT

What is the EPPA? The EPPA is a federal law that protects the rights of employees who are subjected to polygraph testing. The EPPA prohibits employers from using polygraph tests to determine if an employee is telling the truth or to monitor an employee's performance.

Who is covered by the EPPA? The EPPA covers federal government employees and private-sector employers with 100 or more employees who work at the same location for at least 1 year.

What are the EPPA polygraph testing procedures? Employers must provide employees with advance notice of their polygraph testing. Employers must also provide employees with a copy of the EPPA.

What are the EPPA polygraph testing consequences? If an employer violates the EPPA, the employer may be liable for damages, including back pay, benefits, and reinstatement.

Job Safety and Health IT'S THE LAW!

All workers have the right to:

- A safe workplace.
- Receive a copy of a health statement with your employer or OSHA, or report a work-related injury or illness, without being retaliated against.
- Receive information and training on job hazards, including all hazardous substances in your workplace.
- Request a confidential OSHA inspection of your workplace if you believe there are unsafe or unhealthy conditions. You have the right to have a representative contact OSHA on your behalf.
- Participate (or have your representative participate) in an OSHA inspection and review in advance to the inspection.
- File a complaint with OSHA within 30 days of the violation, online or by mail if you have been retaliated against for using your rights.
- See any OSHA citations issued to your employer.
- Request copies of your medical records, tests that measure hazards in the workplace, and the workplace injury and illness log.

Employers must:

- Provide employees a workplace free from recognized hazards. It is illegal to retaliate against an employee for using any of these rights under the law, including filing a health and safety complaint with you or with OSHA, or reporting a work-related injury or illness.
- Comply with all applicable OSHA standards.
- Notify OSHA within 8 hours of a workplace fatality or within 24 hours of any work-related employee hospitalization, amputation, or loss of an eye.
- Provide required training to all workers in a language and vocabulary they can understand.
- Prominently display this poster in the workplace.
- Post OSHA citations at or near the place of the alleged violations.

Equal Employment Opportunity in THE LAW

What is the EEOC? The EEOC is a federal agency that enforces laws that prohibit employers from discriminating against employees on the basis of race, sex, age, disability, and other characteristics.

Who is covered by the EEOC? The EEOC covers federal government employees and private-sector employers with 15 or more employees who work at the same location for at least 1 year.

What are the EEOC prohibited discrimination practices? The EEOC prohibits employers from discriminating against employees on the basis of race, sex, age, disability, and other characteristics. Prohibited practices include hiring, firing, promotion, demotion, and other employment decisions.

What are the EEOC prohibited discrimination remedies? The EEOC can provide remedies for prohibited discrimination practices, including back pay, benefits, and reinstatement.

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Paycheck Checkup Can Prevent a Tax-Time Surprise

What is a Paycheck Checkup? A Paycheck Checkup is a free service that helps employees verify that their employers are paying them correctly. The service checks the employee's pay rate, overtime pay, and other payroll information.

Who is covered by the Paycheck Checkup? The Paycheck Checkup is available to all employees who work for a private-sector employer with 100 or more employees who work at the same location for at least 1 year.

What are the Paycheck Checkup procedures? Employees must provide their employer with advance notice of their Paycheck Checkup. Employees must also provide their employer with a copy of their payroll information.

What are the Paycheck Checkup consequences? If an employer violates the Paycheck Checkup, the employer may be liable for damages, including back pay, benefits, and reinstatement.

Domestic Violence Leave

What is Domestic Violence Leave? Domestic Violence Leave is a type of leave that allows employees to take time off work to deal with domestic violence. Domestic Violence Leave is available to employees who are victims of domestic violence or who are at risk of domestic violence.

Who is covered by Domestic Violence Leave? Domestic Violence Leave is available to all employees who work for a private-sector employer with 100 or more employees who work at the same location for at least 1 year.

What are the Domestic Violence Leave procedures? Employees must provide their employer with advance notice of their Domestic Violence Leave. Employees must also provide their employer with a copy of their domestic violence incident report.

What are the Domestic Violence Leave consequences? If an employer violates Domestic Violence Leave, the employer may be liable for damages, including back pay, benefits, and reinstatement.



Your Rights as a Worker

What are your rights as a worker? Workers have the right to a safe and healthy workplace, to be paid fairly, and to be treated with respect. Workers also have the right to join a union and to bargain collectively with their employer.

What are the OSHA standards? OSHA standards are the rules that employers must follow to keep their workplaces safe and healthy. OSHA standards cover a wide range of workplace hazards, including safety, health, and environmental hazards.
