The Visible Poor Joel Blau, 1993-05-13 Why after the greatest economic expansion in history and endless proclamations of recovery do most Americans have to step over the homeless nearly every day How has the richest country on earth created a spectacle of public misery that paralyzes politicians and policy makers while forcing average citizens to run a gauntlet of direct moral challenges every time they walk the streets In *The Visible Poor* Joel Blau gives provocative answers to these and many other questions about one of the most difficult issues of our time Disproving many convenient myths that most of the homeless are crazy drug addicts drunks or lazy misfits who brought their sufferings on themselves and moving far beyond conventional political explanations Blau shows that the current crisis was an inevitable result of economic and political changes that swept through American society in recent decades the explosion of low wage jobs systematic cutbacks in social welfare benefits to maintain the work incentive government's failure to provide adequate low cost housing and its virtual abandonment of the mentally ill Blau argues that current government policies at every level are mired in pointless head counting and quick fix solutions that only push the homeless out of sight without touching underlying causes He advocates instead a range of social reforms including a national standard for welfare benefits a higher minimum wage and establishment of a social sector for non profit affordable housing that will meet stiff resistance from those entrenched forces in the labor and housing markets that created widespread homelessness in the first place but that may be our best hope for resolving the current impasse A powerful contribution to public debate on homelessness *The Visible Poor* must be read by concerned citizens as well as by policy makers and advocates

McNamara has brought together the voices of these groups in order to reveal the numerous political economic and social constraints that beset current attempts to solve homelessness In addition the commonly held belief that homelessness is a result of laziness or a poor work ethic is turned on its head to reveal that homelessness is truly a multifaceted and complex issue

Why America Lost the War on Poverty--And How to Win It Frank Stricker,2011-02-01 In a provocative assessment of American poverty and policy from 1950 to the present Frank Stricker examines an era that has seen serious discussion about the causes of poverty and unemployment Analyzing the War on Poverty theories of the culture of poverty and the underclass the effects of Reaganomics and the 1996 welfare reform Stricker demonstrates that most antipoverty approaches are futile without the presence or creation of good jobs Stricker notes that since the 1970s U S poverty levels have remained at or above 11% despite training programs and periods of economic growth The creation of jobs has continued to lag behind the need for them Stricker argues that a serious public debate is needed about the job situation social programs must be redesigned a national health care program must be developed and economic inequality must be addressed He urges all sides to be honest if we don't want to eliminate poverty then we should say so But if we do want to reduce poverty significantly he says we must expand decent jobs and government income programs redirecting national resources away from the rich and toward those with low incomes

Sacred Shelter Susan Greenfield,2018-12-04 Named a Gift Book for the Discerning New Yorker by The New York Times In a metropolis like New York homelessness can blend into the urban landscape For editor Susan Greenfield however New York is the place where a community of resilient remarkable individuals are yearning for a voice Sacred Shelter follows the lives of thirteen formerly homeless people all of whom have graduated from the life skills empowerment program an interfaith life skills program for homeless and formerly homeless individuals in New York Through frank honest interviews these individuals share traumas from their youth their experience with homelessness and the healing they have discovered through community and faith Edna Humphrey talks about losing her grandparents father and sister to illness accident and abuse Lisa Sperber discusses her bipolar disorder and her whiteness Dennis Barton speaks about his unconventional path to becoming a first generation college student and his journey to

reconnect with his family The memoirists share stories about youth family jobs and love They describe their experiences with racism mental illness sexual assault and domestic violence Each of the thirteen storytellers honestly expresses his or her brokenheartedness and how finding community and faith gave them hope to carry on Interspersed among these life stories are reflections from program directors clerics mentors and volunteers who have worked with and in the life skills empowerment program In his reflection George Horton shares his deep gratitude for and solidarity with the 500 plus individuals he has come to know since he co founded the program in 1989 While religion can be divisive Horton firmly believes that all faiths urge us to welcome the stranger and as Pope Francis asks accompany them through the struggles of life Through solidarity and suffering many formerly homeless individuals have found renewed faith in God and community Beyond trauma and strife Dorothy Day s suggestion that All is grace is personified in these thirteen stories Jeremy Kalmanofsky rabbi at Ansche Chesed Synagogue says the program points toward a social fabric of encounter and recognition between strangers who overcome vast differences to face one another which in Hebrew is called Panim el Panim While Sacred Shelter does not tackle the socioeconomic conditions and inequities that cause homelessness it provides a voice for a demographic group that continues to suffer from systemic injustice and marginalization In powerful narrative form it expresses the resilience of individuals who have experienced homelessness and the hope and community they have found By listening to their stories we are urged to confront our own woundedness and uncover our desire for human connection a sacred shelter on the other side of suffering

Wright,2009 Homelessness in America has grown from a minor problem in isolated areas of a few big cities into a near epidemic Today scarcely any American city of any appreciable size lacks homeless people Homeless shelters and programs have become as essential and as commonplace as police protection or water and sewage treatment What to do for with or about the homeless is a nagging and complex social policy issue debated at all levels of government Address Unknown emphasizes the large scale social and economic forces that have priced an increasingly large segment of the urban poor completely out of the housing market Seen in this light the problem of homelessness is that there are too many extremely poor people competing for too few affordable housing units The nation would be facing a formidable homelessness problem even if there were no alcoholics no drug addicts no deinstitutionalized mentally ill people no personal pathologies of any kind Rather than a choice homelessness is the result of housing markets that have very little to offer to extremely poor people The plight of the homeless is very visible and Address Unknown is one of the first major investigative studies into the nature and multiple causes of the problem Wright considers demographic economic sociological and social
