Ross, Øystein Tunsjø, Dong Wang, 2020-10-15 This book examines the power transition between the US and China and the implications for Europe and Asia in a new era of uncertainty The volume addresses the impact that the rise of China has on the United States Europe transatlantic relations and East Asia China is seeking to use its enhanced power position to promote new ambitions the United States is adjusting to a new superpower rivalry and the power shift from the West to the East is resulting in a more peripheral role for Europe in world affairs Featuring essays by prominent Chinese and international experts the book examines the US China rivalry the changing international system grand strategies and geopolitics foreign policy geo economics and institutions and military and technological developments The chapters examine how strategic security and military considerations in this triangular relationship are gradually undermining trade and economics reversing the era of globalization and contributing to the breakdown of the US led liberal order and institutions that will be difficult to rebuild The volume also examines whether the adversarial antagonism in US China relations the tension in transatlantic ties and the increasing rivalry in Europe China relations are primarily resulting from leaders ambitions or structural power shifts This book will be of much interest to students of Asian security US foreign policy European politics and International Relations in general

Power, Perception and Foreign Policymaking Scott Brown, 2017-11-13 This book examines the changing dynamics of power in the international arena since the end of the Cold War Brown engages in analysis of how the United States and the European Union have responded to the so called rise of China through an examination of how policymakers' perceptions of China have changed over time and influenced their policy choices This study undertakes rigorous analysis of how these perceptions have evolved between 1989 and 2009/2016 offering a comparative perspective on the similarities and differences between the policy discourse and behaviour within these two Western powers Brown argues that China's rise is a contested notion with varied perceptions of how the implications of China's ascendancy have shaped policy preferences in ways that are inconsistent with concerns over the threat of an impending power transition Combining concepts and methods derived from IR and FPA the book examines the linkages between great power politics and policymakers' competing interpretations of key international actors and their influence upon foreign policies The main objective of the study is to illuminate the different ways in which the US and the EU have responded to the rise of China through a close analysis of their decision making processes and outcomes across a series of key encounters and events including the transatlantic debate over the EU's proposal to lift its China arms embargo 2003-2005 Undertaking qualitative analysis of the development of American and European policymakers' perceptions of China this book will be of interest to graduates and scholars of post Cold War international politics Foreign Policy Analysis policymaking US China relations and EU China relations

European Foreign and Security Policy towards China Claude Zanardi, 2022-11-08 This book explores the foreign and security policies of Germany France and the UK vis vis China Despite the progress made by the Lisbon Treaty and notwithstanding the first EU Global Strategy the European Union does not have

a strategy to address the rise of China Since this strategic deficit does not automatically reflect the level of EU member states this book argues that the vacuum at EU level provides member states with an opportunity to fill this gap By assuming that an increase in national policies on China would eventually lead to a comprehensive European strategy for China the author focuses on the three biggest European countries and looks at the rise of China to understand the development of the EU s Common Foreign and Security Policy vis vis the PRC While the CFSP depends on the contribution of EU member states their role in shaping the CFSP towards China has not been researched yet and this book fills the gap
