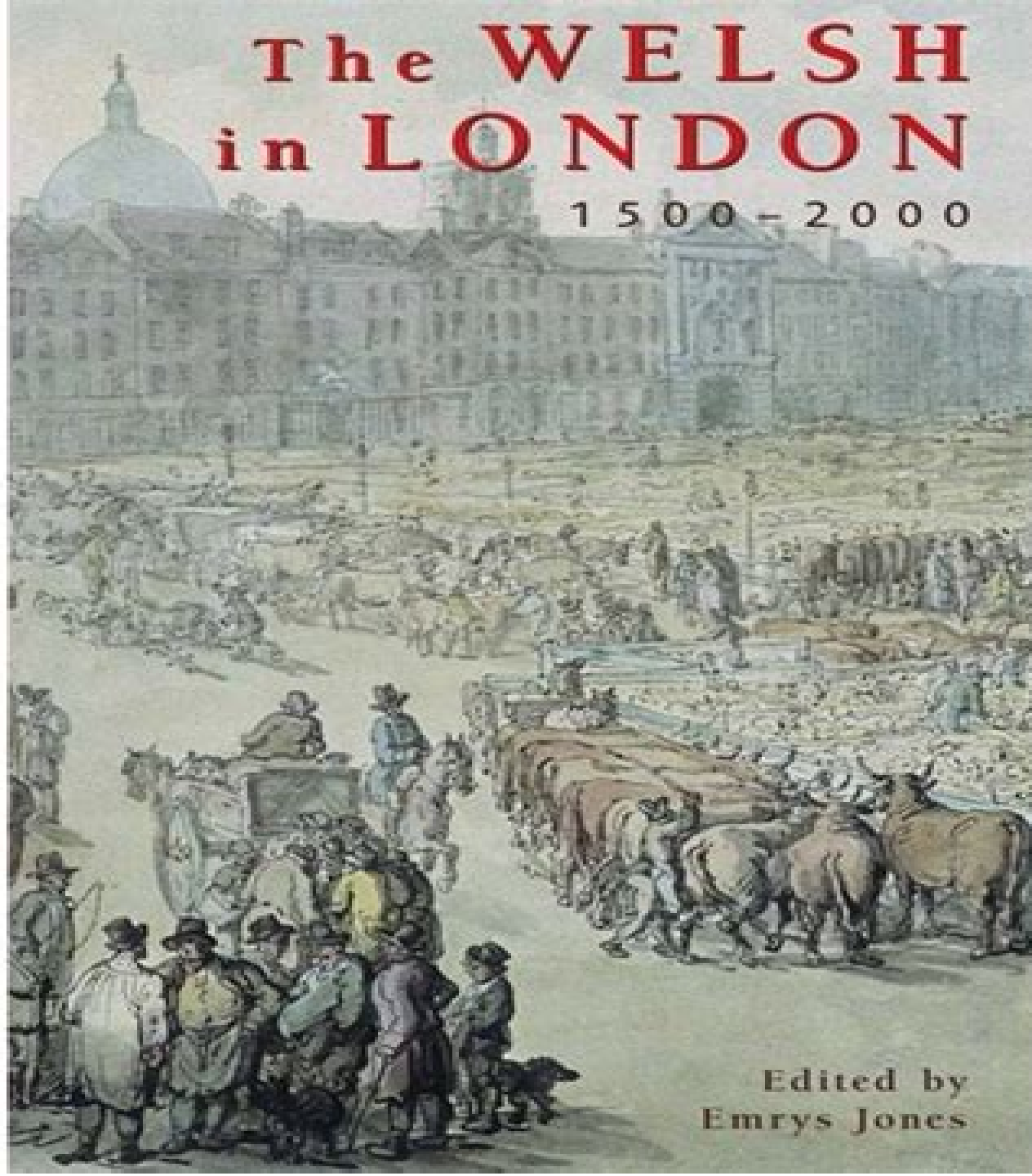

Jones,2015-11-20 The first book on Rebecca Riots since 1989 The book looks at the Rebecca riots protest movement in Victorian Wales in a context informed by not only British and European historiography but also other disciplines including literature and anthropology The book is informed by recent work in cultural and gender history which it applies for the first time to the symbolic and ritual content of the protests The book s epilogue discusses historical protest in the context of the contemporary resurgence of leaderless extra parliamentary protest around the world including Occupy Anonymous and anti austerity movements

Bard of Liberty Geraint H. Jenkins,2012-07-15 This is the first full scale study of the political radicalism of Iolo Morganwg the renowned Welsh romantic whose colourful life as a Glamorgan stonemason poet writer political activist and humanitarian made him one of the founders of modern Wales This path breaking volume offers a vivid portrait of a natural contrarian who tilted against the forces of the establishment for the whole of his adult life Known as the Bard of Liberty or the little republican bard he moved in highly politicized circles embraced republicanism founded the Gorsedd of the Bards of the Isle of Britain threw in his lot with Unitarians promoted a sense of cultural nationalism and supported the anti slave trade campaign and the anti war movement during years of war oppression and cruelty

The Letters of Dr Charles Burney ,2025-04-29 This second volume of the letters of Dr Charles Burney follows directly from the first published in 1991 and contains roughly two hundred letters written between 1785 and 1793 In these years Burney consolidated his reputation as a musicologist publishing his account of the Commemoration of Handel 1785 and completing A General History of Music 1789 Continuing to teach he had a busy schedule filled with dinners assemblies and concerts During these years Burney moved from St Martin s Street to the Royal Hospital Chelsea where he held the post of organist He remained active in musical circles helping to promote foreign musicians and young performers He welcomed Josef Haydn to London in 1791 As a proprietor of the Pantheon which burned down in 1792 Burney noted competing efforts to establish a new opera house He helped organize the musical band taken on Lord Macartney s embassy to China in 1792 Seeking materials for his research Burney borrowed

manuscripts from George III and corresponded with colleagues in England and abroad Burney also discussed literary subjects and contributed to the Monthly Review A friend of Horace Walpole he socialized with the Bluestockings He was a frequent attendee at the Literary Club and supplied Boswell with anecdotes of Johnson Burney writes movingly of the passing of the artist Sir Joshua Reynolds Having married twice Burney kept in touch with a large family and visited his daughters in Mickleham Surrey and Aylmer Norfolk He tried to help his son Charles Burney Jr restore his reputation after the disgrace of expulsion from Cambridge and supported his daughter Frances on accepting and then resigning from a position in the Queen's Household Initially alarmed when she married a penniless French migrant he soon began to lobby on behalf of French migrant priests and enlisted Frances to pen a pamphlet for the cause While holding strong views himself Burney kept friends on both sides of the political divide Burney was closely engaged with the musical literary scientific and political circles of his day Informative and entertaining his letters add considerably to our knowledge of the man and the age

The Valiant Welshman, the Scottish James, and the Formation of Great Britain Megan Lloyd, 2018-12-03 When James VI of Scotland and I of England proclaimed himself King of Great Britain he proposed a merger of parliaments as he had joined two crowns in his own person ascending the throne of England in 1603 For James the Cambro Celtic past led to an Anglo Scottish present and Wales stood as the ideal Although the parliamentary union of Great Britain was not initiated for another 100 years Parliament's denial failed to deter James from wanting a Great Britain and R A's play The Valiant Welshman became part of the public spectacle of unity required to nurture James's dream The Valiant Welshman the Scottish James and the Formation of Great Britain considers national regional and linguistic identity and explores how R A's play promotes Wales serves King James and reveals what it means to be Welsh and Scots in a newly forming Great Britain

Animal Cities Peter Atkins, 2016-04-15 Animal Cities builds upon a recent surge of interest about animals in the urban context Considering animals in urban settings is now a firmly established area of study and this book presents a number of valuable case studies that illustrate some of the perspectives that may be adopted Having an urban history flavour the book follows a fourfold agenda First the opening chapters look at working and productive animals that lived and died in nineteenth century cities such as London Edinburgh and Paris The argument here is that their presence yields insights into evolving understandings of the category urban and what made a good city Second there is a consideration of nineteenth century animal spectacles which influenced contemporary interpretations of the urban experience Third the theme of contested animal spaces in the city is explored further with regard to backyard chickens in suburban Australia Finally there is discussion of the problem of the public companion animal and its role in changing attitudes to public space illustrated with a chapter on dog walking in Victorian and Edwardian London Animal Cities makes a significant contribution to animal studies and is of interest to historical geographers urban cultural social and economic historians and historians of policy and planning
