

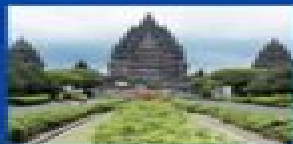
The Department of Sociology and Anthropology and the
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UNESCO in Southeast Asia: World Heritage Sites in Comparative Perspective

The region's 31 UNESCO World Heritage Sites make a significant contribution to national prestige, international profile, and government plans for domestic and international tourism development. Yet we still know very little about these sites in comparative terms. They are globally important, but they are also locally demarcated sites which are the focus of cultural encounters, social and political conflicts, and tensions and accommodations between competing interests (international agencies, national governments, government agencies, NGOs, tourists and local communities). They provide the ideal laboratories for multi-disciplinary scrutiny and analysis, bringing together perspectives from history, political science, geography-ecology, sociology and anthropology.

A three-year project (2009-2012) funded by The British Academy to examine a range of both cultural and natural sites across seven countries in the Southeast Asian region is the first comparative research programme to consider how sites are being managed and how they are coping with the conflicting pressures to which they are subject in a globalizing heritage industry and in national policies and development plans. In comparing sites within and beyond a particular country it is hoped to draw out lessons for best practice to feed into UNESCO and national government approaches to heritage, conservation and tourism development.
