Together, they highlight the misrepresented image of Indigenous groups in the Amazon who are portrayed as different, even strange, in relation to Western culture. The argument put forward is that both exotic and self-exoticization rely on the notion of otherness, leading to romanticization, patronization, and caricature. The book will be of particular interest to scholars of Indigenous studies, Latin American studies, cultural studies, anthropology, and comparative literature.
