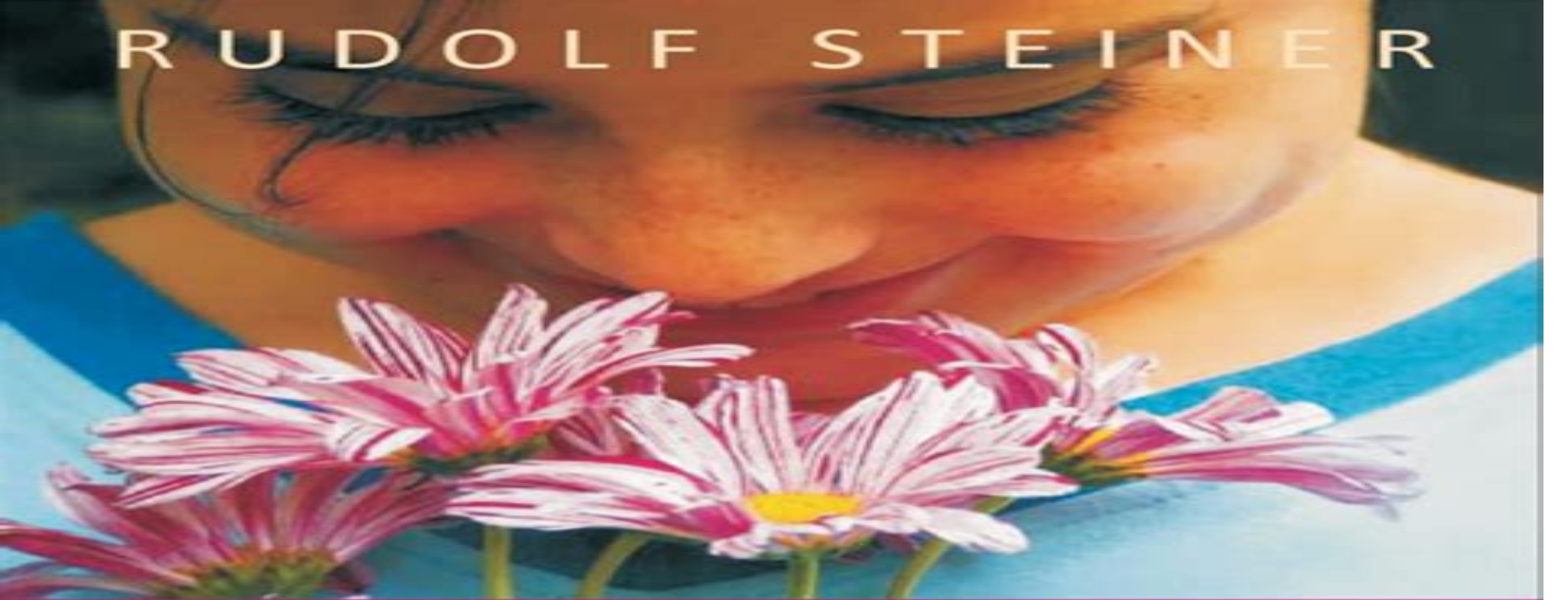

What Is Waldorf Education Three Lectures:

What Is Waldorf Education? Rudolf Steiner, 2004-11 The soul's immortality and its repeated earthly births are not new ideas in Western thought. They are implicit in the Pythagorean and Platonic traditions as well as in some branches of esoteric Judaism and Kabbala. But it was not until the early years of this century that the West was given a detailed modern evolutionary philosophy of human life based on the reality of reincarnation and karma. This turning point occurred when Rudolf Steiner began to make public the results of his spiritual scientific researches. He viewed the revelation of reincarnation and karma as one of his most important life tasks. Steiner's contribution however remains unique in its understanding of the human being as an evolving developing being of body, soul and spirit. On the basis of his researches presented in numerous books and lectures we begin to understand how the complex interaction of human lives between birth and death and between death and a new birth gives new meaning not only to individual lives lived on Earth in community with others but also to human history and evolution and to earthly and cosmic events. This book collects many of Steiner's major statements on reincarnation and karma. The primary purpose of this volume is to help readers meet the challenge of spiritual research in the area of individual evolution of the soul and spirit in the context of cultural and universal evolution. Such a study can be tremendously revealing and provide spiritual understanding in a time of increasing intellectual confusion and spiritual poverty. The notion of reincarnation and karma is generally associated in most minds with spiritual traditions of the East especially Hinduism and Buddhism. Ren Querido's in depth sixty page introduction however places these concepts within the context of Western spiritual development and esoteric tradition showing us a panoramic view of how such ideas have developed over the centuries in the West.

Three Lectures on the Mystery Dramas Rudolf Steiner, 1983 Rudolf Steiner wrote four mystery dramas intended to portray the spiritual path of self knowledge as described by spiritual science or Anthroposophy. Those plays are not merely symbolic but realistic depictions in a spiritual sense. In this book Steiner describes how *The Portal of Initiation* the first of his dramas portrays the intense and tempestuous inner events of initiation as experienced by a young painter. He explains the spiritual background of this character's karmic tests and higher guidance. He also discusses the Rosicrucian nature of this play as well as the symbolism and fantasy of the second drama *The Soul's Probation*. Steiner also emphasizes the power of certain fairy tales and poetry for bridging the gap between the spiritual and material worlds. As one of the mystery dramas shows this is especially valuable for those who tend to be intellectuals. Rudolf Steiner portrayed much of the wisdom of his spiritual science in the mystery dramas and intended them to graphically depict what he taught all his life. As he said: If people will exert themselves to work with the drama I will not have to give any more lectures for a long time.

The main body of *The Bhagavad Gita and the West* consists of two lecture courses by Rudolf Steiner: *The Bhagavad Gita and the Epistles of Paul* and *The Esoteric Significance of the Bhagavad Gita*. In the first course, his main purpose is to integrate the flower of Hindu spirituality into his view of the evolution of consciousness and the pivotal role played in it by the Mystery of Golgotha, the incarnation, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ. Steiner views Krishna as a great spiritual teacher and the Bhagavad Gita as a preparation, though still abstract, for the coming of Christ and the Christ impulse as the living embodiment of the World Law and Devotion represented by the three Hindu streams of Veda, Sankhya, and Yoga. For Steiner, the epic poem of the Bhagavad Gita represents the fully ripened fruit of Hinduism, whereas Paul is related but represents the seed of something entirely new. In the last lecture of part one, Steiner reveals Krishna as the sister soul of Adam incarnated as Jesus and claims Krishna's Yoga teachings streamed from Christ into Paul. In the second lecture course, five months later, Steiner engages the text of the Bhagavad Gita on its own terms as signaling the beginning of a new soul consciousness. To aid in understanding both of these important cycles, this book includes the complete text of the Bhagavad Gita in Eknath Easwaran's luminous translation.
