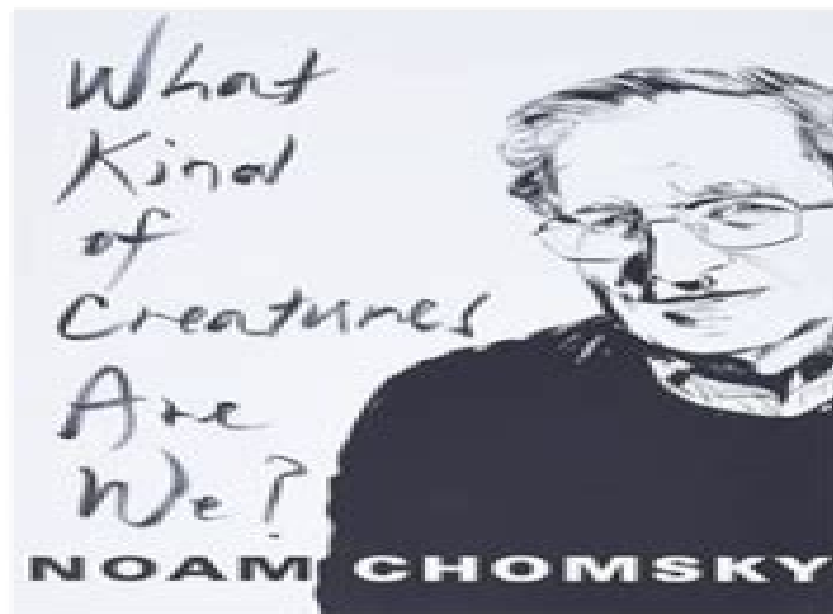

In particular, polysemous phenomena should typically be treated as semantic ambiguity.
