Go forth to the land that I will show you Genesis 12 1 Rabbi El azar ignores idiomatic usage and insists on reading the words more literally than they were intended hyperliterally Lekh lekha Go to yourself Search deep within to discover your true self At times the companions themselves become the main characters and we read about their dramatic mystical sessions with Rabbi Shim on or their adventures on the road for example an encounter with a cantankerous old donkey driver who turns out to be a master of wisdom in disguise Ultimately the plot of the Zohar focuses on the ten sefirot the various stages of God s inner life aspects of divine personality both feminine and masculine By penetrating the literal surface of the Torah the mystical commentators transform the biblical narrative into a biography of God The entire Torah is read as one continuous divine name expressing divine being Even a seemingly insignificant verse can reveal the inner dynamics of the sefirot how God feels responds and acts how She and He the divine feminine and masculine relate intimately with each other and with the world The Zohar Daniel C.
