## **1: Lamarckism (Theory of Acquired Characters)**

Lamarckism was proposed by Jean-Baptiste de Monet Lamarck in the year 1744-1829. This theory was based on the principle that all the physical changes occurring in an individual during its lifetime are inherited by its offspring. This idea is also called the **inheritance of acquired characteristics**.

Lamarck based his theory on two observations:

- Individuals lose characteristics they do not require (or use) and develop characteristics that are useful.
- Individuals inherit the traits of their ancestors.

oriented philosophy of science has taken up the challenge implicit in the latter two criticisms i.e. to develop accounts of science that would be more adequate for understanding the development of real life science. One of the more successful products of this branch of philosophy of science is Lakatos's theory of scientific development sometimes called the methodology of scientific research programmes. This theory conceives science as consisting of so-called research programmes developing in time and competing with each other over the issue which one generates the best explanations of the phenomena that they address.
