and other related disciplines **Transitional Justice in Nepal** Yvette Selim, 2018-06-27 The conflict in Nepal 1996-2006 resulted in an estimated 15 000 deaths 1 300 disappearances along with other serious human rights and humanitarian law violations Demands for peace democracy accountability and development have abounded in the post conflict context Although the conflict catalysed major changes in the social and political landscape in Nepal the transitional justice TJ process has remained deeply contentious and fragmented This book provides an in depth analysis of the transitional justice process in Nepal Drawing on interviews with a diverse range of stakeholders including victims ex combatants community members human rights advocates journalists and representatives from diplomatic missions international organisations and the donor community it reveals the differing viewpoints knowledge attitudes and preferences about TJ and other post conflict issues in Nepal The author develops an actor typology and an action spectrum which can be used in Nepal and other post conflict contexts The actor typology identifies four main groups of TJ actors experts brokers implementers and victims and highlights who is making claims and on behalf of whom The action spectrum based on contentious politics literature and resistance literature demonstrates the strategies actors use to shape the TJ process This book argues that the potential of TJ lies in these dynamics of contention It is by letting these dynamics play out that different conceptualisations of TJ can arise While doing so may lead to practical challenges and produce situations that are normatively undesirable for some actors particularly when certain political parties and national actors seem to hijack TJ remaining steadfast to the dominant TJ paradigm is also undesirable As the first book to provide a single case study on TJ in Nepal it makes theoretical and empirical contributions to TJ research in Nepal and the Asia Pacific more broadly the politics versus justice binary and the concept of victimhood among others It will be of interest to a wide range of scholars in the study of transitional justice peace and conflict studies human rights sociology political science criminology law anthropology and South Asian Studies as well as policy makers and NGOs **Gender, Transitional Justice and Memorial Arts** Jelke Boesten, Helen Scanlon, 2021-05-17 This book examines the role of post conflict memorial arts in bringing about gender justice in transitional societies Art and post violence memorialisation are currently widely debated Scholars of human rights and of commemorative arts discuss the aesthetics and politics not only of sites of commemoration but of literature poetry visual arts and increasingly film and comics Art memory and activism are also increasingly intertwined But within the literature around post conflict transitional justice and critical human rights studies there is little questioning about what memorial arts do for gender justice how women and men are included and represented and how this intertwines with other questions of identity and representation such as race and ethnicity The book brings together research from scholars around the world who are interested in the gendered dimensions of memory making in transitional societies Addressing a global range of cases including genocide authoritarianism civil war electoral violence and apartheid they consider not only the gendered commemoration of past violence but also the possibility of producing counter narratives that unsettle and challenge established stereotypes Aimed at

house demolitions the expropriation of land the crime of apartheid and the blockade of Gaza are dealt with in light of the Rome Statute and international law On the basis of the established theories of transitional justice the possible impacts of an ICC investigation and prosecution on the conflict are analysed and a number of insights are shared with regard to the impacts of the ICC on combatting impunity fostering Palestine's statehood peace negotiations and the stability of the region Due to the politicisation of the conflict and the various interests at stake the impact of the ICC's involvement on the credibility of the ICC itself is also reviewed Recognizing the numerous impacts of the conflict on the existence of the two nations and the multitude of causes for its perpetuity it does not limit itself to the ICC but also provides other conflict resolution alternatives that could enable reconciliation and sustainable peace in the region This book provides an array of opinions and a crucial input for researchers and practitioners alike while it is also useful to those investigating and possibly involved in prosecutions regarding Palestine or other similar situations before the ICC

div Guarantees of Non-Repetition in International Human Rights Law and Transitional Justice Nita Shala, 2024-06-07 This book examines the understudied yet increasingly applied concept of Guarantees of Non-Repetition under international human rights law and transitional justice Guarantees of Non-Repetition GNRs are measures taken to ensure that human rights abuses do not recur They are especially crucial in post war contexts marked by severe and systematic violations However although they are increasingly invoked GNRs are not well understood and they have so far received only limited theoretical and practical analysis Tracing their development to the influence of international human rights law this book considers what GNRs are how and why they have come about and how GNRs are implemented Through an explication of the history law and jurisprudence of GNRs in regional mechanisms in Latin America Europe and Asia as well as in international bodies the book maintains the increasing importance and as yet unfulfilled potential of this legal obligation in transitional justice settings This first book to analyse the development of GNRs and their application will appeal to scholars in the areas of law and transitional justice public policy and socio legal studies as well as lawyers and policy makers working in post conflict situations

Theorizing 'Transitional Justice' David Anton Hoogenboom, 2014 Early literature in the field of transitional justice was dominated by debates over the meaning of justice with retributivists arguing for the need for criminal prosecutions following mass human rights violations and advocates of restorative justice claiming that non prosecutorial forms of justice like truth telling are better suited for post conflict societies This debate was eventually settled at least in the field by a belief that post conflict societies require both criminal prosecutions and truth telling More recently the debate over justice has centred on the question of whether the field and practice of transitional justice has prioritized civil and political rights over economic and social rights While this is a significant development in the field it points to a more fundamental reality Debates over justice are interminable To try to sculpt justice to fit a preconceived definition limits its capacity to respond to the needs of survivors This realization serves as the starting point for this project that justice must remain open to re interpretation for it to maintain its relevance in post conflict societies There is however a central problem in the field Transitional justice implies a justice that is in the service of the transition What this suggests then is that the debates over justice or the justice question have been substantially circumscribed by the transition question thereby limiting the possible definitions of justice While the justice question has received a great deal of attention this project suggests that if debates over justice are to indeed remain interminable the more fundamental concern of the field should be the way the transition question has in fact shaped our theorizing about justice

The Conceptual Foundations of

Transitional Justice Colleen Murphy, 2017-04-19 Many countries have attempted to transition to democracy following conflict or repression but the basic meaning of transitional justice remains hotly contested In this book Colleen Murphy analyses transitional justice showing how it is distinguished from retributive corrective and distributive justice and outlines the ethical standards which societies attempting to democratize should follow She argues that transitional justice involves the just pursuit of societal transformation Such transformation requires political reconciliation which in turn has a complex set of institutional and interpersonal requirements including the rule of law She shows how societal transformation is also influenced by the moral claims of victims and the demands of perpetrators and how justice processes can fail to be just by failing to foster this transformation or by not treating victims and perpetrators fairly Her book will be accessible and enlightening for philosophers political and social scientists policy analysts and legal and human rights scholars and activists

Justice Framed Marcos Zunino, 2019-03-14 Why are certain responses to past human rights violations considered instances of transitional justice while others are disregarded This study interrogates the history of the discourse and practice of the field to answer that question Zunino argues that a number of characteristics inherited as transitional justice emerged as a discourse in the 1980s and 1990s have shaped which practices of the present and the past are now regarded as valid responses to past human rights violations He traces these influential characteristics from Argentina's transition to democracy in 1983 the end of communism in Eastern Europe the development of international criminal justice and the South African truth commission of 1995 Through an analysis of the post World War II period the decolonisation process and the Cold War Zunino identifies a series of episodes and mechanisms omitted from the history of transitional justice because they did not conform to its accepted characteristics

After Violence Elin Skaar, Camila Gianella Malca, Trine Eide, 2015-04-17 *After Violence* Transitional Justice Peace and Democracy examines the effects of transitional justice on the development of peace and democracy Anticipated contributions of transitional justice mechanisms are commonly stated in universal terms with little regard for historically specific contexts Yet a truth commission for example will not have the same function in a society torn by long term civil war or genocide as in a society emerging from authoritarian repression Addressing trials reparations truth commissions and amnesties the book systematically addresses the experiences of four very different contemporary transitional justice cases post authoritarian Uruguay and Peru and post conflict Rwanda and Angola Its analysis demonstrates that context is a crucial determinant of the impact of transitional justice processes and identifies specific contextual obstacles and limitations to these processes The book will be of much interest to scholars in the fields of transitional justice and peacebuilding as well as students generally concerned with human rights and democratisation
