Finger Spread

Spread the putty like a pancake over your fingers and thumb. Try to spread them apart.



Finger Scissor

Place a 1 inch thick piece of putty between each pair of fingers and squeeze together.



Finger Pinch

Pinch the putty between each finger and the thumb.
