

Word Choice

- Poets may vary **syntax** (word order) to create poetic effects (i.e., not subject + verb+object, “prose-like”);
- Poets may explore **repetition** (i.e., “**parallelism**” or “**anaphora**”);
- Poets consider **diction** (“high,” or formal, vs. “low,” or slang/idiom);
- Poets consider **connotation and denotation** (levels of meaning);
- Poets orchestrate the sound of words or word groups (“**cadence groups**”) with (“**assonance**,” repetition of vowel sounds/OR “**alliteration**,” repetition of consonant sounds) to produce the “music” of the poem;
