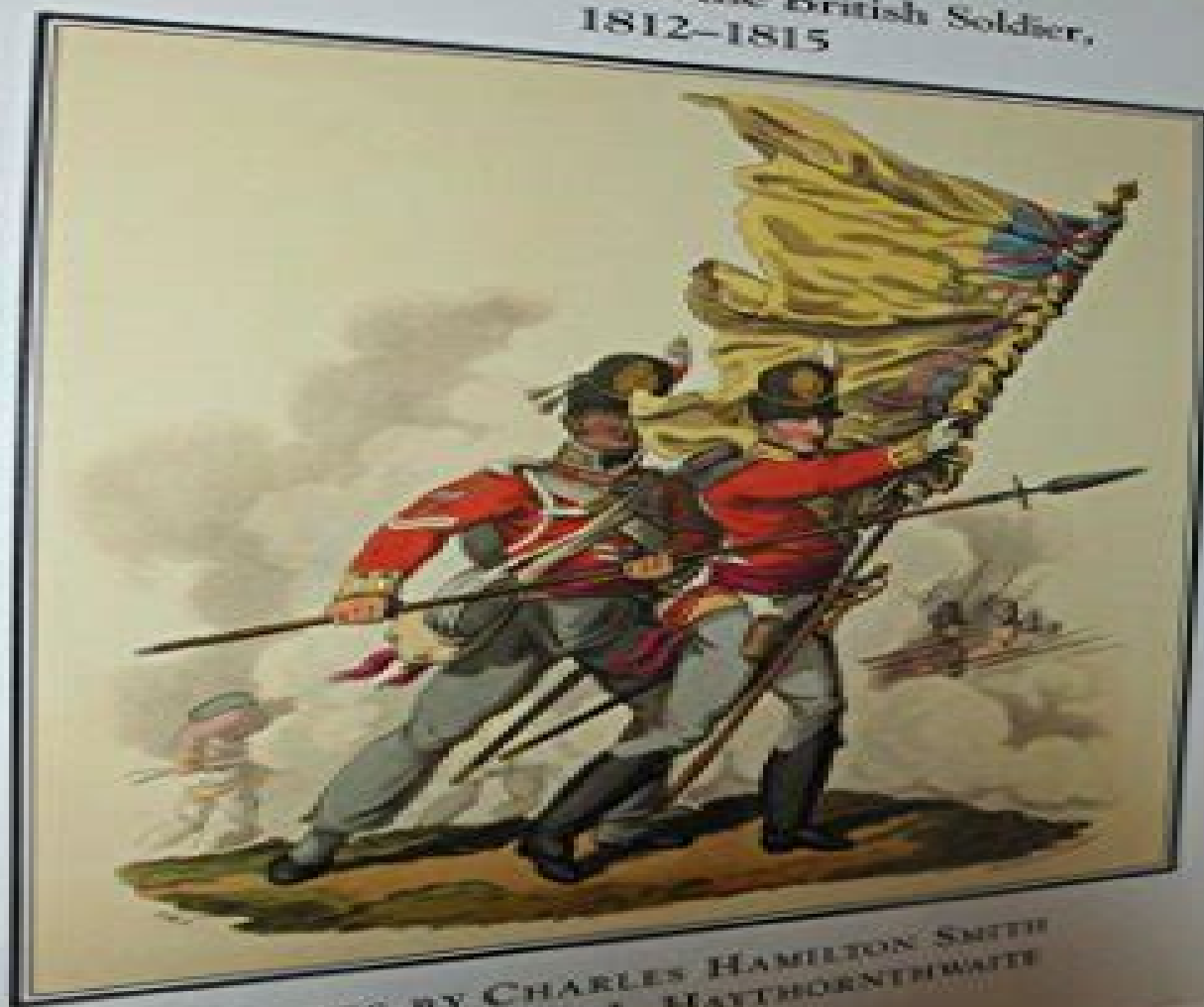

The plates drawn from life and completed in 1814 cover all the branches of service including line infantry, light infantry and rifles, heavy and light cavalry, general officers, foreign troops, artillery and engineers and cadets and veterans. Each plate is accompanied by an incisive text by the leading expert on Wellington's troops, Philip Haythornthwaite, which discusses the unit in question, the uniform and its significant features. Wellington's Army also includes an extensive introduction analyzing the evolution of the British Army of the period and examining the colorful life of Charles Hamilton Smith. This volume covers both British cavalry and artillery of the Napoleonic Wars as well as supporting units such as engineers. Gabriele Esposito describes the history, organization and uniforms of the various units in full detail, following the evolution and combat history of each. Mounted troops deployed in the various British colonies as well as foreign cavalry units in British service will be all covered in specific chapters. The technical corps, most notably the artillery, both foot and horse, and the engineers are given similar treatment. Royal Marines, naval infantry and some other auxiliary corps like the Yeomanry militia, cavalry or the Sea Fencibles, all very little known, are also included. The years from 1800 to 1815 were one of the most glorious periods for the British Army and the infantry was its backbone. Lavishly illustrated with color artwork, this book examines how the foot regiments evolved to absorb the lessons of defeat in America, transforming them into the efficient and dependable bedrock of victory in the Napoleonic Wars. Historian Gabriel Esposito details the uniforms, equipment and weapons of the infantry along with their organization and tactics. Chapters are devoted to the Guards, the line regiments of foot, the Light Infantry and Rifles as well as Highland and Lowland Scots regiments. Esposito considers not only those units serving with Wellington in the Peninsular War and the Waterloo Campaign but all British infantry units including those in Canada, the West Indies, India and elsewhere, including the home defense Fencibles. The Waterloo Armies Philip Haythornthwaite, 2007-10-18 German troops formed the majority of Wellingtons forces present at the Battle of Waterloo including those of Nassau Brunswick Hanover and the Kings German Legion and they have left a large number of first hand accounts of their role in the battle The actions of the King s German Legion an integral part of the British Army and partly officered by British soldiers has been published in English but to a limited degree Herbert Siborne published letters written to his father Ompteda and Wheatley have had their memoirs published and History of the Kings German Legion included a small number of letters including the oft misquoted account of the defence of La Haye Sainte by Major Baring This forms a tiny proportion of the German material available Therefore it is not surprising that early British histories of the battle have largely sidelined the achievements of the German troops and this has been regurgitated by most that have followed This situation did not change until the 1990s when Peter Hofschroer published his two volume version of the campaign from the German perspective which included snippets of German documents published in English for the first time But even this proved not totally satisfactory as it did not provide the whole document to allow full interpretation There is a great need to provide an English version of much of the original German source material to redress the imbalance this volume is intended to remedy that situation by publishing sixty of these reports and letters fully translated into English for the first time giving a clearer insight into the significant role these troops played Gareth Glover is a historian specialising in the Waterloo campaign and the Peninsular War He left school at eighteen to join the Royal Navy as a Seaman Officer and completed his extensive training course at Dartmouth College He has published articles in The Waterloo Journal and the Journal of the Royal Artillery and a novel about Waterloo Voices of Thunder Christmas Selection 2010 Napoleon org website
