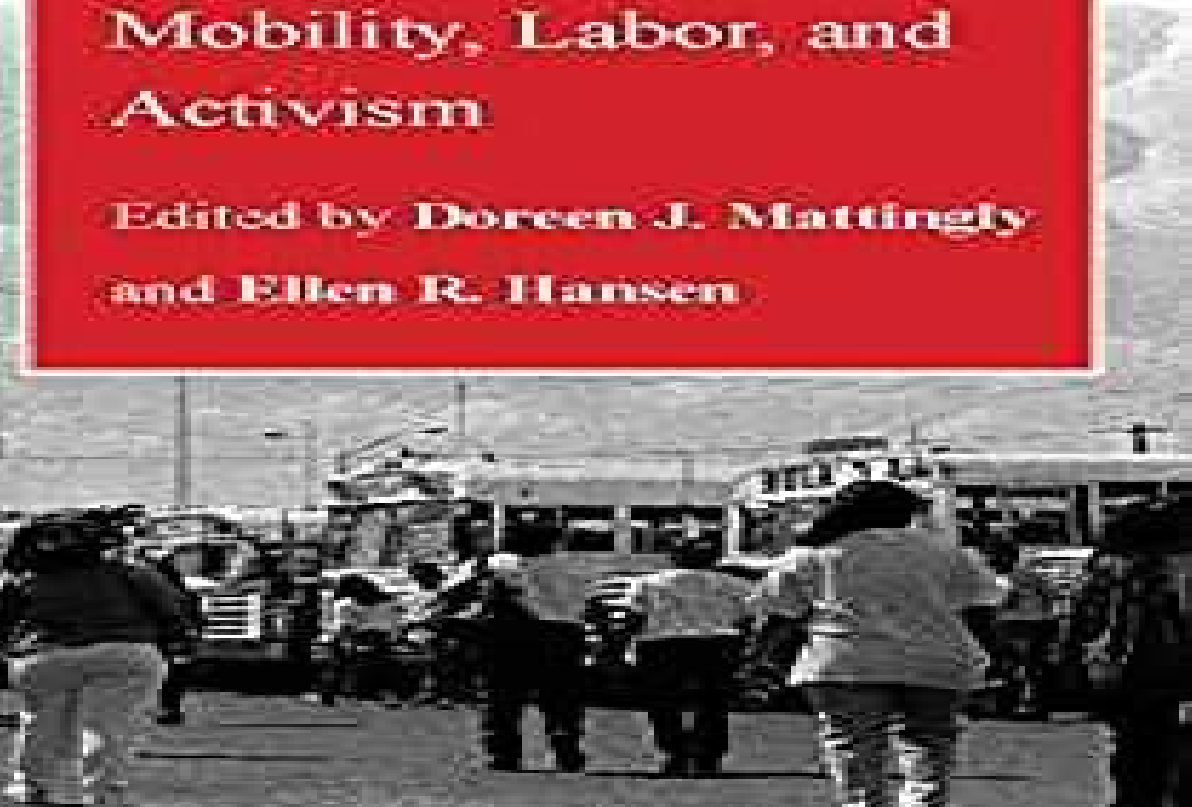

Hansen, 2008-03-20 There is no denying that the U S Mexico border region has changed in the past twenty years With the emergence of the North American Free Trade Agreement NAFTA the curtailment of welfare programs and more aggressive efforts by the United States to seal the border against undocumented migrants the prospect of seeking a livelihood particularly for women has become more tenuous in the twenty first century In the face of the ironic juxtaposition of free trade and limited mobility this book takes a new look at women on both sides of the border to portray them as active participants in the changing structures of life often engaging in political struggles The contributions including several chapters by Mexican as well as U S scholars examine environmental and socioeconomic conditions on the border as they shape and are shaped by both daily life at the local level and the global economy The contributors focus on issues related to migration both short and long term empowerment especially reflecting shifts in women s consciousness in the workplace and political and social activism in border communities The chapters consider a broad range of topics such as the changing gender composition of the maquiladora work force over the past decade and border women s non governmental organizations and political activism In most of the studies both sides of the border are considered to provide insights into differences created by an international boundary and similarities produced by cross border interactions Together these chapters show the border region to be a dynamic social economic cultural and political context in which women face both obstacles and opportunities for change and make clear the vital role that women play in shaping the border region and their own lives This collection builds on Susan Tiano and Vicki Ruiz s groundbreaking volume *Women on the U S Mexico Border* by continuing to show the human face of changes wrought by manufacturing and militarization By illustrating the current state of social science research on gender and women s lives in the region it offers fresh perspectives on the material reality of women s daily lives in this culturally and historically rich region **Women and**

Borders defined broadly to include territorial dividing lines as well as sociocultural boundaries have become increasingly salient sites of struggle over social belonging and cultural and material resources. How do contemporary activists navigate and challenge these borders? What meanings do they ascribe to different social cultural and political boundaries and how do these meanings shape the strategies in which they engage? Moreover how do these social movements confront internal borders based on the differences that emerge within social change initiatives? *Border Politics* edited by Nancy A Naples and Jennifer Bickham Mendez explores these important questions through eleven carefully selected case studies situated in geographic contexts around the globe. Markets, Community and Just Infrastructures Nancy Neiman,2020-06-08 A series of market related crises over the past two decades financial environmental health education poverty reinvigorated the debate about markets and social justice Since then counter hegemonic movements all over the globe are attempting to redefine markets and the meaning of economic enterprise in people s daily lives Assessments of market outcomes tend toward the polemical with capitalists and socialists globalization advocates and anti globalization movements those on the political right and those on the left all facing off to argue the benefits or harms brought about by markets Yet not enough attention has been paid to analyzing the conditions under which markets result in just outcomes This book explores how culture politics and ideology help shape market incentives in an attempt to reclaim the language of economic rationality and the policymaking legitimacy that accompanies it Through a variety of case studies labor relations in the U S meatpacking industry the globalization process in Jua rez Mexico financial reform in Cuba and an interfaith Ugandan coffee cooperative this book provides a framework for understanding the conditions under which markets promote just or unjust outcomes e g discrimination income inequality environmental degradation or racial justice human rights and equitable growth This book touches on subject matter as varied as food religion banking and race and gender equality from a multi disciplinary perspective It offers an analysis of markets based on community rather than pure individualism that has the potential to change the way we think about economic rationality An accessible and compelling read this book will appeal to students and scholars in political science economics sociology geography gender studies critical race studies environmental studies and all those interested in the critique of mainstream economics and neoliberal logic

Mora,Alberto Dávila,2022-04-12 Five million workers are employed in a variety of settings along the U S Mexico border yet labor market outcomes on each side often differ U S workers tend to have low earnings and high unemployment compared with the rest of the country while workers on the Mexican side of the border are often more prosperous than those in the interior This book sheds new light on these socioeconomic differentials along with other labor market issues affecting both sides of the border The contributors take up issues that dominate the current discourse migration trade gender education earnings and employment They analyze labor conditions and their relationship to immigration and also provide insight into income levels and population concentrations the relative prosperity of Mexico s border region and NAFTA s impact on trade

and living conditions Drawing on demographic economic and labor data the chapters treat topics ranging from historical context to directions for future research They cover the importance of trade to both the United States and Mexico salary differentials the determinants of wages among Mexican immigrant women on the U S side and the net effect of Mexican migration on the public coffers in U S border states The book s concluding policy prescriptions are geared toward improving conditions on the U S side without dampening the success of workers in Mexico Written to be equally accessible to social scientists policy makers and concerned citizens this book deals with issues often overlooked in national policy discussions and can help readers better understand real life conditions along the border It dispels misconceptions regarding labor interdependence between the two countries while offering policy recommendations useful for improving the economic and social well being of border residents

Daughters and Granddaughters of Farmworkers Barbara Wells, 2013-11-15 In *Daughters and Granddaughters of Farmworkers* Barbara Wells examines the work and family lives of Mexican American women in a community near the U S Mexican border in California s Imperial County Decades earlier their Mexican parents and grandparents had made the momentous decision to migrate to the United States as farmworkers This book explores how that decision has worked out for these second and third generation Mexican Americans Wells provides stories of the struggles triumphs and everyday experiences of these women She analyzes their narratives on a broad canvas that includes the social structures that create the barriers constraints and opportunities that have shaped their lives The women have constructed far more settled lives than the immigrant generation that followed the crops but many struggle to provide adequately for their families These women aspire to achieve the middle class lives of the American Dream But upward mobility is an elusive goal The realities of life in a rural agricultural border community strictly limit social mobility for these descendants of immigrant farm laborers Reliance on family networks is a vital strategy for meeting the economic challenges they encounter

Wells illustrates clearly the ways in which the long shadow of farm work continues to permeate the lives and prospects of these women and their families

The Undocumented Everyday Rebecca M. Schreiber, 2018-03-13 Examining how undocumented migrants are using film video and other documentary media to challenge surveillance detention and deportation As debates over immigration increasingly become flashpoints of political contention in the United States a variety of advocacy groups social service organizations filmmakers and artists have provided undocumented migrants with the tools and training to document their experiences In *The Undocumented Everyday* Rebecca M Schreiber examines the significance of self representation by undocumented Mexican and Central American migrants arguing that by centering their own subjectivity and presence through their use of documentary media these migrants are effectively challenging intensified regimes of state surveillance and liberal strategies that emphasize visibility as a form of empowerment and inclusion Schreiber explores documentation as both an aesthetic practice based on the visual conventions of social realism and a state administered means of identification and control As Schreiber shows by visualizing new ways of belonging not necessarily defined by citizenship these migrants are remaking documentary media combining formal visual strategies with those of amateur photography and performative elements to create a mixed genre aesthetic In doing so they make political claims and create new forms of protection for migrant communities experiencing increased surveillance detention and deportation

Mexican Women in American Factories Carolyn Tuttle, 2012-11-01 Prior to the millennium economists and policy makers argued that free trade between the United States and Mexico would benefit both Americans and Mexicans They believed that NAFTA would be a win win proposition that would offer U S companies new markets for their products and Mexicans the hope of living in a more developed country with the modern conveniences of wealthier nations Blending rigorous economic and statistical analysis with concern for the people affected *Mexican Women in American Factories* offers the first assessment of whether NAFTA has fulfilled these expectations by examining its socioeconomic impact on workers in a Mexican border town Carolyn Tuttle led a group that interviewed 620 women maquila workers in Nogales Sonora Mexico The responses from this representative sample refute many of the hopeful predictions made by scholars before NAFTA and reveal instead that little has improved for maquila workers The women s stories make it plain that free trade has created more low paying jobs in sweatshops where workers are exploited Families of maquila workers live in one or two room houses with no running water no drainage and no heat The multinational companies who operate the maquilas consistently break Mexican labor laws by requiring women to work more than nine hours a day six days a week without medical benefits while the minimum wage they pay workers is insufficient to feed their families These findings will make a crucial contribution to debates over free trade CAFTA DR and the impact of globalization

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
