Theology, Disability, and Spiritual Transformation Michael Hryniuk, 2014-05-14 In this study Michael Hryniuk develops a full phenomenological psychological and theological account of spiritual transformation in the context of L Arche a federation of Christian communities that welcome persons with learning disabilities The book begins with a critical examination of current perspectives on spiritual transformation in theology and Christian spirituality and constructs a new foundational formulation of transformation as a shift in consciousness identity and behavior Through extensive analysis of the narratives of the caregiver assistants who share life with those who are disabled this case study reveals an alternative vision of the three fold way that unfolds through a series of profound awakenings in relationships of mutual care and presence an awakening to the capacity to love to bear inner anguish and darkness and to experience radical human and divine acceptance The book examines the psychological dimensions of spiritual transformation through the lens of contemporary affect theory and explores how care givers experience a profound healing of shame in their felt sense of identity and self worth

Reinders, 2010-07-15 The village of Trosly Breuil in northern France is home to one of the world's thirty-four L'Arche communities where people with and without intellectual disabilities live and work together In 2007 the impressive group of social scientists and theologians who contribute to this book gathered there to respond to a question posed by the worldwide community's cofounder Jean Vanier What have people with disabilities taught me Editor Hans Reinders emphasizes that the purpose of these analyses and reflections is not to set those with disabilities apart He explains that it is not their being disabled that makes them special but rather that sharing their experience enables us to see things that we otherwise readily ignore and to understand the fullness of what it means to be human *Balm for the Wound? Narratives and Spiritual Practice from L'Arche* Catherine Mary Anderson, 2016 Building on previous research on people living with an intellectual disability this study mainly focuses on practices employed in L'Arche communities In particular it investigates the manner in which the community provides a balm for the metaphorical wound experienced by persons living with intellectual disability The study employs a practical narrative theological methodology in which pastoral theology pastoral care and spirituality are considered central components Together with this Lee's appropriation of Aristotle's three ways of knowing is essential parts of the methodology praxis represents an important aspect of L'Arche Further the author introduces an expression of praxis techné as artwork for this thesis Theology of disability is part of the methodology However this is not of primary concern Rather than concentrate on for example a history of disability this author considers life experience and how persons living with a disability contribute to and enrich the lives of other persons The Christian theme of death and new life flows through the thesis This is a hallmark of L'Arche yet the author justifies how this crosses the boundaries of religions and cultures in L'Arche A focal point considers the profound grief of a woman living with an intellectual disability and her journey from an institution to L'Arche Daybreak Toronto Further the reader is introduced to a seven-step Christopraxis welcome response by Daybreak L'Arche community to this grieving woman A second major study in the thesis is the attention to the artwork of persons living with an intellectual disability which thematically is in sharp contrast to the study of grief The research findings are Christopraxis is a way of knowing or understanding the identity of L'Arche Daybreak The artwork of persons living with an intellectual disability represents a way of knowing or understanding differently This articulates with the viewer of this art who knows understands differently through contemplating this art Encounter with Mystery Frances Margaret Young, 1997 **Disability and Spirituality** William C. Gaventa, 2018 Disability and spirituality have traditionally been understood as two distinct spheres disability is physical and thus belongs to health care professionals while spirituality is religious and belongs to the church synagogue or mosque and their theologians clergy rabbis and imams This division leads to stunted theoretical understanding limited collaboration and segregated practices all of which contribute to a lack of capacity to see people with disabilities as whole

human beings and full members of a diverse human family Contesting the assumptions that separate disability and spirituality William Gaventa argues for the integration of these two worlds As Gaventa shows the quest to understand disability inevitably leads from historical and scientific models into the world of spirituality to the ways that values attitudes and beliefs shape our understanding of the meaning of disability The reverse is also true The path to understanding spirituality is a journey that leads to disability to experiences of limitation and vulnerability where the core questions of what it means to be human are often starkly and profoundly clear In *Disability and Spirituality* Gaventa constructs this whole and human path before turning to examine spirituality in the lives of those individuals with disabilities their families and those providing care their friends and extended relationships and finally the communities to which we all belong At each point Gaventa shows that disability and spirituality are part of one another from the very beginning of creation Recovering wholeness encompasses their reunion a cohesion that changes our vision and enables us to everyone as fully human
