and translations are constrained by poetic form personal histories state control public morality and the non availability of comparable target language subcodes and how translator creativity may or may not overcome these constraints Topics covered are Baudelaire s translation practices bowdlerism in translations of Voltaire Boccaccio and Shakespeare among others Leyris s translations of Gerard Manley Hopkins ideology in English Arabic translation the translation of censored Greek poet Rhea Galanaki theatre translation Nabokov and translation gay translation Morat n s translation of Hamlet and state control of translation production in Nazi Germany The essays are mostly highly readable and often entertaining
