Japan's Foreign Aid Policy in Africa Pedro Amakasu Raposo, 2014-11-20 Japan's Foreign Aid Policy in Africa seeks to evaluate TICAD's intellectual contribution to and its development practices regarding Africa over the past 20 years. A central conclusion is that while TICAD bureaucrats lacked agency to support Japanese companies in Africa, the model of emerging powers partnerships has expanded in Africa.

Reconciliation Discourse Annelies Verdoolaege, 2008-02-06 This volume is a research monograph analysing the South African Truth and Reconciliation Commission (TRC) from an ethnographic linguistic point of view. The central proposition of this book is that the TRC can be regarded as a mechanism that leads to the hegemony of specific discourses thus exercising power. The analysis illustrates how through a certain type of reconciliation discourse constructed at the TRC hearings a reconciliation oriented reality took shape in post-TRC South Africa. Basically, the study points to the long-term implications a truth commission can exert on a traumatised post-conflict society. The book is unique on several levels. TRC discourse is explored in depth on the basis of personal stories from TRC testifiers. A combination of Poststructuralist and Critical Discourse Analysis approaches form the theoretical foundations and an extensive bibliography provides an impressive database of TRC publications.

ERDA. ,1976 Truth and Reconciliation Commission Processes Karen Brounéus, 2018-11-27 After war, does truth telling lead to more peaceful attitudes between former enemies? This book is the first to study the over-time effect of a Truth and Reconciliation Commission (TRC) process on people's attitudes towards peace. Focusing on the Solomon Islands TRC process, one of the least known or studied TRC processes in the world, and using surveys, focus groups, and in-depth interviews, the book reveals some critical issues for peacebuilding. For example, while support of the TRC was consistently quite strong over the two years of the study, there was a sharp decline in trust in the process as well as a significant increase in distrust and suspicion towards ex-combatants over the two-year period. The book shows that the ex-combatants did not feel safe to tell the truth in the TRC and had therefore decided beforehand what to say in the hearings. A systematic telling of untruths thereby took place, severely undermining relationships and peacebuilding in the country. The book weaves the findings from the Solomon Islands with experiences of other post-conflict truth-telling processes around the world and suggests practical guidelines for future TRC processes after war.

Truth Commissions and Transitional Societies Eric Wiebelhaus-Brahm, 2010-01-05 Despite the increasing frequency of truth commissions, there has been little agreement as to their long-term impact on a state's political and social development. This book uses a multi-method approach to examine the impact of truth commissions on subsequent human rights protection and democratic practice. Providing the first cross-national analysis of the impact of truth commissions and presenting detailed analytical case studies on South Africa, El Salvador, Chile, and Uganda, author Eric Wiebelhaus-Brahm examines how truth commission investigations and their final reports have shaped the respective societies. The author demonstrates that in the longer term, truth commissions have often had appreciable effects on human rights but more limited
