magic The practitioner must purify himself through a temperate diet regular sleep and thorough attention to cleaning and hygiene A complete description of tools like a magical lamp rod sword and dagger follows leaving the magician well equipped to perform ceremonies and rituals L vi also added the Tarot to the tools of the magician which was a new development in the occultism of the time Although L vi didn't enjoy much notoriety during his life his works eventually became highly influential among other occultists and he is now considered one of the fathers of modern mysticism Famous occultist Aleister Crowley even claimed to be L vi himself in one of his past lives Additionally Arthur Edward Waite and Pamela Colman Smith created the Waite Smith deck based on Eliphas L vi's writings which is the basis for most modern Tarot decks
