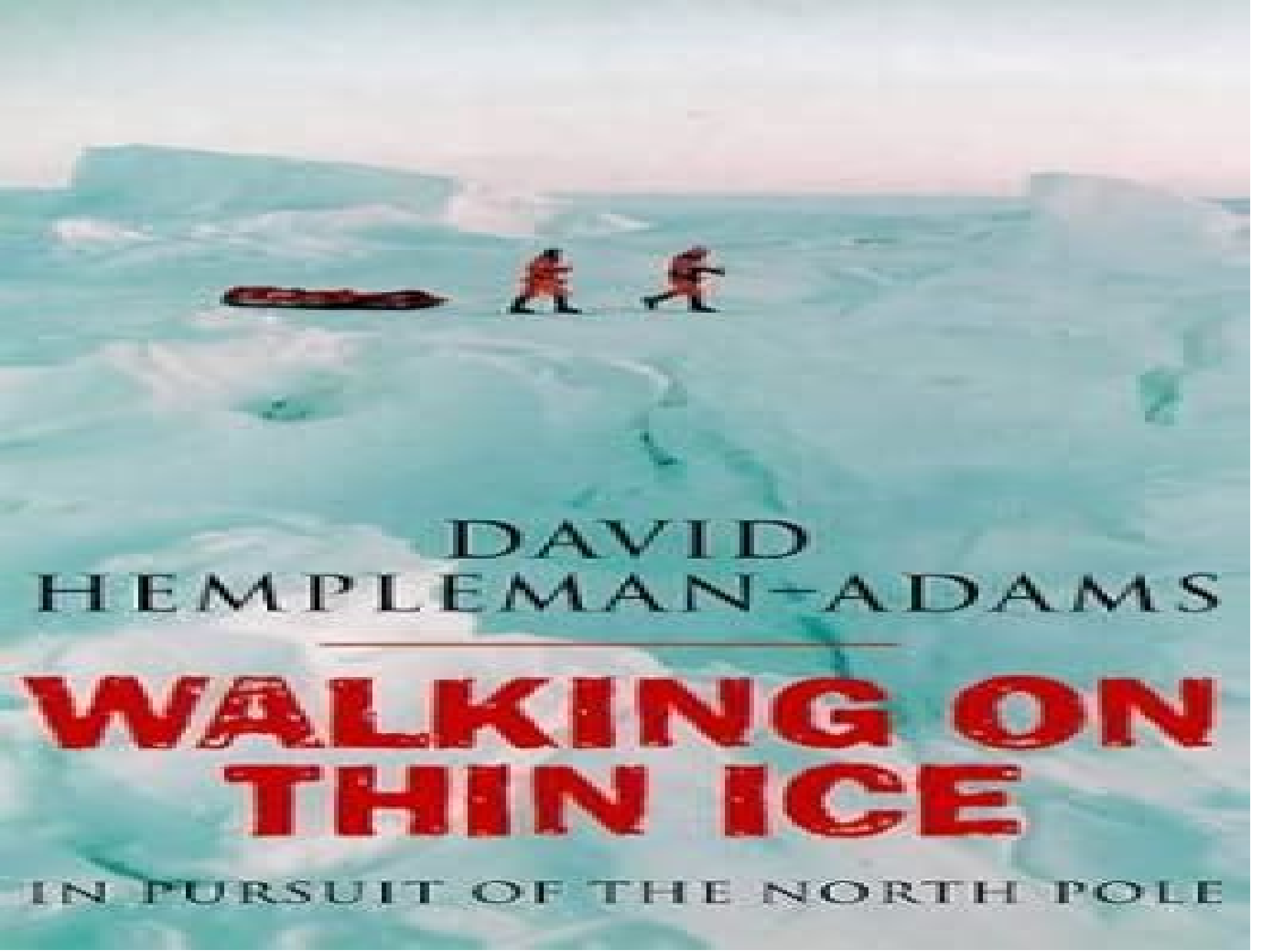

German Exploration of the Polar World David Thomas Murphy,2002-01-01 German Exploration of the Polar World is the exciting story of the generations of German polar explorers who braved the perils of the Arctic and Antarctic for themselves and their country Such intrepid adventurers as Wilhelm Filchner Erich von Drygalski and Alfred Wegener are not as well known today as Robert Falcon Scott Roald Amundsen Ernest Shackleton Robert E Peary or Richard E Byrd but their bravery and the hardships they faced were equal to those of the more famous polar explorers In the half century prior to World War II the poles were the last blank spaces on the global map and they exerted a tremendous pull on national imaginations Under successive political regimes the Germans threw themselves into the race for polar glory with an ardor that matched their better known counterparts bearing English American and Norwegian flags German polar explorers were driven like their rivals by a complex web of interlocking motivations Personal fame the romance of the unknown and the advancement of science were important considerations but public pressure political and military concerns and visions of immense untapped wealth at the poles also spurred the explorers As historian David Thomas Murphy shows Germany's repeated encounters with the polar world left an indelible impression upon the German public government and scientific community Reports on the polar landscape flora and fauna enhanced Germany's appreciation of the global environment Accounts of the indigenous peoples of the Arctic accurate or fantastic permanently shaped German notions of culture and civilization The final failed attempt by the Nazis to extend German political power to the earth's ends revealed the limits of any country's ability to reshape the globe politically or militarily

The Philosophers Stone Of Expedition Leadership W. A. Donkin,2006-11-02

The interest in and inspiration for this book was derived from the author's background experience and knowledge of adventure expeditions This valuable experience can be detected within the text of this work but its attractiveness is derived from the observation of other experienced members of expedition teams around the world The challenge of adventure expeditions are part of the reason why expedition leaders and team members choose to face unfamiliar situations such as difficult weather or terrain changes in travel plans or using new equipment and adventurous pursuit in a strange or unknown place The problems to be faced can of course never be fully predicted The challenge of this uncertainty is one of the reasons why people become involved in expeditions but it is also the source of conflict and danger It is the management of these diverse and changing factors that are the concern of the leader a complex and dynamic process It can be implied that adventurous expeditions are demanding experiences full of opportunities and potential problems This later proposition can be justified as a result of previous bad practice and unsavoury incidents within the sphere of outdoor adventure The indications are that expedition leaders need to share good practice and should possess the required leadership qualities They need to consider developing suitable guidelines that could give an outline of the roles and responsibilities of an expedition

leader There appears to be a need to identify the desired qualities of expedition leaders in order to develop the essential professional training programmes and safe expeditions that use good practice SAS Col. Thomas A. Hillary, 2009-10-07

This book provides an insight into my lifetime experiences from birth to the present day It also concentrates thoroughly on defining the qualities desired of an SAS military leader In terms of personal experiences of leadership I would say that the military provided me with a blueprint of acceptable leadership behaviours Looking at the training I went through with Special Forces reveals some of the unique qualities that are required to fulfil this role I would say that conventional military regiments differed somewhat to the democratic even abdicratic approach of Special Forces units such as the SBS SAS and 2REP French Foreign Legion While I was serving with the Marines I wanted to transfer to a Special Forces unit but was refused entry to the organisation because of my commitment to the Marines This was a great issue at the time but I eventually rejoined the SAS regiment anyway after resigning from the Marines My first period of SAS training followed passing of the usual Battle Fitness Test BFT that was completed while at a barracks off the King s Road in Chelsea I can explain that my first thoughts about joining the SAS occurred in 1976 when I was serving as a junior guardsman at Pirbright in Surrey The inspiration came from my platoon commander who had previously been a member of the Guards Independent Parachute Brigade This was a unit that largely preceded G Squadron of the SAS Regiment Later actions then included the Iranian embassy incident under direction of the Counter Revolutionary Warfare CRW team and patrols in areas of Northern Ireland that were subject to violent terrorist actions I served also with 23 and 21 between 1985 and 1992 and the Scots Guards and French Foreign Legion experiences came early in my career The Spectator ,1999 **The Publishers Weekly** ,1999
