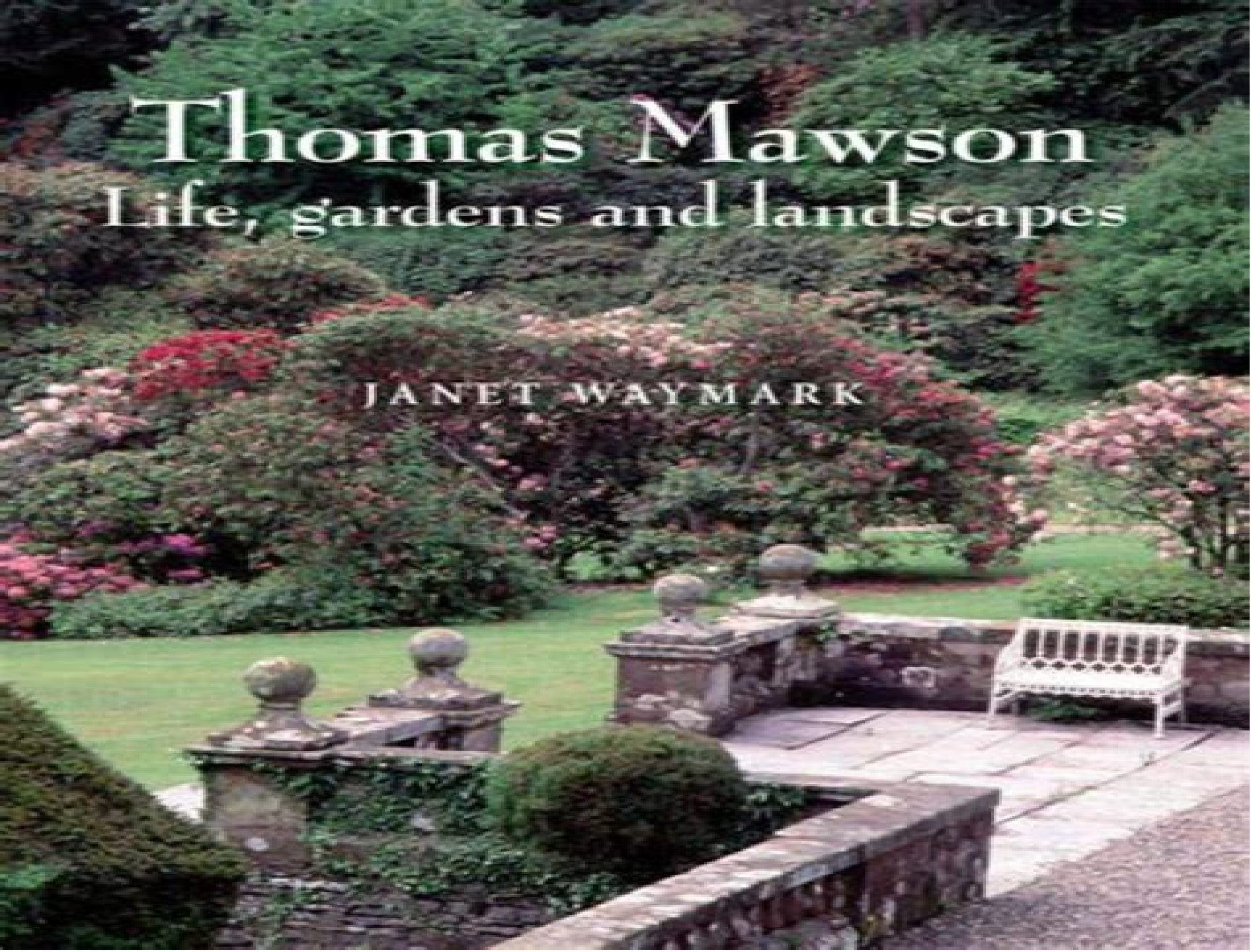

Thomas Mawson Janet Waymark, 2009 Widely regarded as a master landscape architect Thomas Mawson 1881 1933 began designing gardens in the 1890s Though he came from humble beginnings he was soon the most sought after garden and landscape designer of the day and could name crowned heads of Europe as his clients and friends as well as self made industrialists such as Lord Leverhulme and Andrew Carnegie He developed his distinctive style in the gardens of England s Lake District where his genius allowed his creations to open out into the countryside Now this full scale biography examines the brilliance that still endures in his landscapes and designs Present both in private gardens and civic spaces Mawson s unique talents have influenced garden designers and landscape architects for nearly a century His widespread legacy is given the attention it deserves in this beautifully illustrated book by renowned architecture historian Janet Waymark

England's Magnificent Gardens Roderick Floud, 2021-06-15 An altogether different kind of book on English gardens the first of its kind a look at the history of England s magnificent gardens as a history of Britain itself from the seventeenth century gardens of Charles II to those of Prince Charles today In this rich revelatory history Sir Roderick Floud one of Britain s preeminent economic historians writes that gardens have been created in Britain since Roman times but that their true growth began in the seventeenth century by the eighteenth century nurseries in London took up 100 acres with ten million plants that were worth more than all of the nurseries in France combined Floud s book takes us through more than three centuries of English history as he writes of the kings queens and princes whose garden obsessions changed the landscape of England itself from Stuart Georgian and Victorian England to today s Windsors Here are William and Mary who brought Dutch gardens and bulbs to Britain William who twice had his entire garden lowered in order to see the river from his apartments and his successor Queen Anne who like many others since vowed to spend little on her gardens and instead spent millions Floud also writes of Frederick Prince of Wales the founder of Kew Gardens who spent more than 40 000 on a single twenty five foot tulip tree for Carlton House Queen Victoria who built the largest most advanced and most efficient kitchen garden in Britain and Prince Charles who created and designed the gardens of Highgrove inspired by his boyhood memories of his grandmother s gardens We see Sarah Duchess of Marlborough who created a magnificent garden at Blenheim Palace only to tear it apart and build a greater one Deborah Duchess of Devonshire the savior of Chatsworth s 100 acre garden in

the midst of its 35 000 acres and the gardens of lesser mortals among them Gertrude Jekyll and Vita Sackville West both notable garden designers and writers We see the designers of royal estates among them Henry Wise William Kent Humphrey Repton and the greatest of all English gardeners Capability Brown who created the 150 acre lake of Blenheim Palace earned millions annually and designed more than 170 parks many still in existence today We learn how gardening became a major catalyst for innovation central heating came from experiments to heat greenhouses with hot water pipes how the new iron industry of industrializing Britain supplied a myriad of tools mowers pumps and the boilers that heated the greenhouses and finally Floud explores how gardening became an enormous industry as well as an art form in Britain and by the nineteenth century was unrivaled anywhere in the world *Hertfordshire Garden History Volume 2* Deborah Spring,2012 This second volume of Hertfordshire garden history considers how Hertfordshire s historic parks and gardens have been influenced by and reflect the social and economic history of their time Beginning with the hunting parks and Renaissance gardens of the Bacons Cecils and Capels in the 16th and 17th centuries and their gradual replacement by designed landscape this book shows how in Hertfordshire individuals have long sought greater space and comfort within easy reach of the capital London With examples from both well known and less visible or vanished gardens from the past 500 years it is sure to delight garden enthusiasts Community Green David Nichols, Robert Freestone, 2024-02-06 Neighbourhood open space ranks highly as a key component in suburban liveability assessments originating from the development of urban planning as a profession and the proliferation of the garden suburb Community Green uniquely connects the past present and future of planning for small open spaces around the narrative of internal reserves The distinctive planned spaces are typically enclosed on every side hidden within residential blocks serving as local pocket parks and reflecting the evolving values of community life from the garden city movement to contemporary new urbanism This book resuscitates the enclosed almost secretive reserve from history as a distinctive form of local open space whose problems and potentialities are relevant to many other green community spaces In so doing it opens up even wider connections between localism and globalism the past and the future and for connecting community initiatives to broader global challenges of cohesion health food and climate change This fully illustrated book charts the outcomes and implications of this evolution across several continents injecting human stories of civic initiatives struggles and triumphs along the way Community Green will be of interest to a wide readership interested in studying managing and improving the quality of all small open spaces in the urban landscape The factory in a garden Helena Chance, 2017-02-28 When we think about Victorian factories Dark Satanic Mills might spring to mind images of blackened buildings and exhausted exploited workers struggling in unhealthy and ungodly conditions But for some employees this image was far from the truth and this is the subject of *The Factory in a Garden* which traces the history of a factory gardens movement from its late eighteenth century beginnings in Britain to its twenty first century equivalent in Google s vegetable gardens at their headquarters in California The book is the first study of its kind examining the
