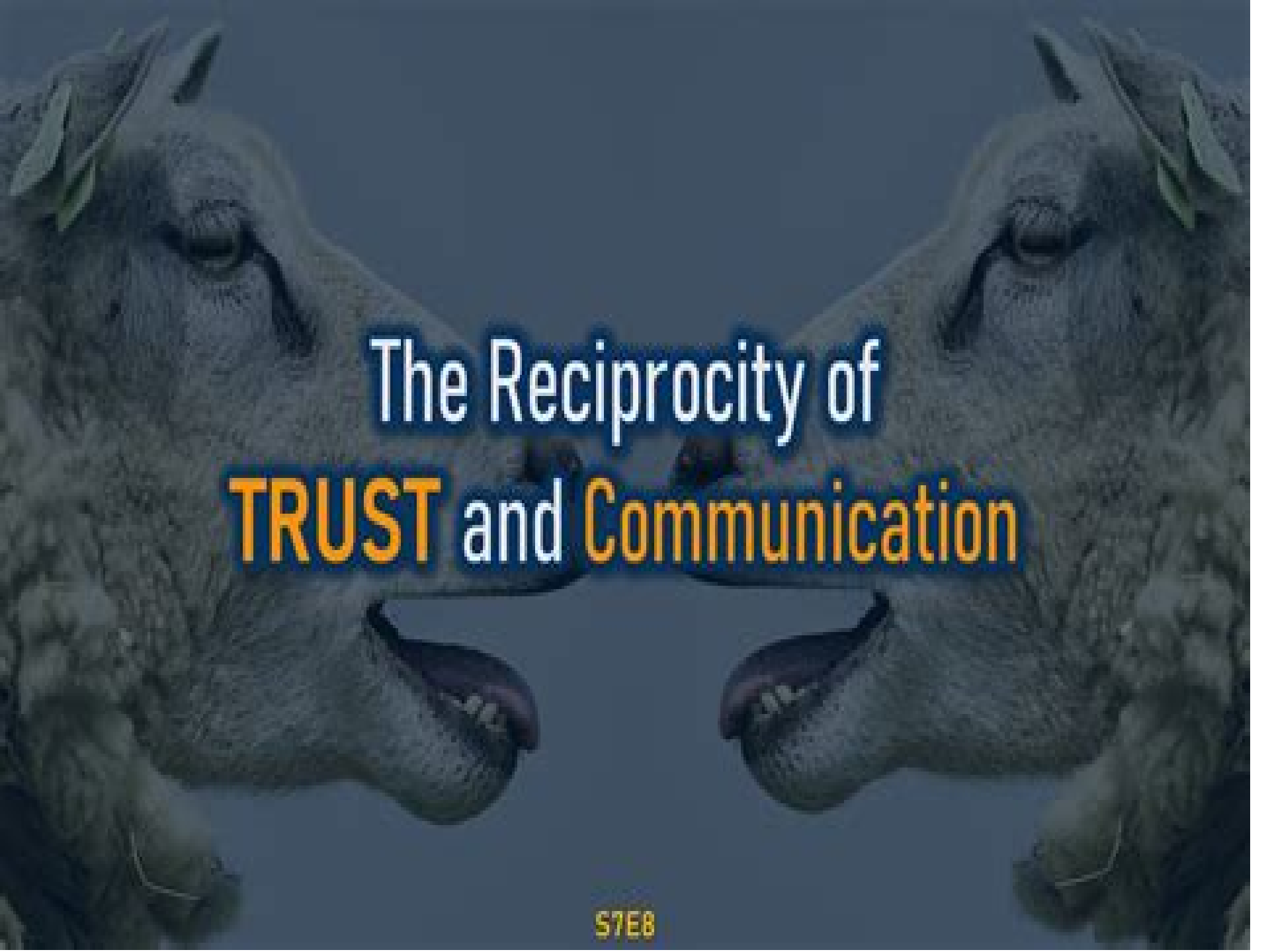

Representative Trust and Reciprocity Thomas J. Dohmen, Armin Falk, David Huffman, Uwe Sunde, 2008 This paper provides evidence about the determinants of trust and reciprocal inclinations that is a tendency for people to respond in kind to hostile or kind actions in a representative setting We investigate the prevalence of reciprocity in the population the correlation between trust and positive and negative reciprocal inclinations within person the individual determinants of reciprocity and the relationship with psychological measures of personality We find that most people state reciprocal inclinations in particular in terms of positive reciprocity as well as substantial heterogeneity in the degree of trust and reciprocity Trust and positive reciprocity are only weakly correlated while trust and negative reciprocity exhibit a negative correlation In terms of determinants being female and increasing age are associated with stronger positive and weaker negative reciprocal tendencies Taller people are more positively reciprocal but height has no impact on negative reciprocity Psychological traits also affect trust and reciprocity JEL D63 J3 J6

Trust and Reciprocity Fei Song, 2006 This paper presents evidence that trust and reciprocity behavior and perceptions is sensitive to whether people are making decisions solely on their own behalf or when they are given the responsibility to act on behalf of their groups Employing the widely used experimental framework of the trust game Berg et al 1995 with salient monetary payoffs I examine and contrast the level of trust and reciprocity exhibited by individuals in inter individual interactions with those exhibited by the same individual when he she is responsible for a group decision The results suggest that people trust less and reciprocate less

when responsible for a group or organizational decision I also explore perceptions about trust and reciprocity behavior of one's own and that of others in the study and find that there are disconnections between perspectives of parties involved about the interaction and the actual observed behavior. The evidence reported here is consistent with the idea that people are poor at making hypothetical predictions; highlights the disconnections between behavioral forecasts and behavior. Lastly, this paper also makes an important advance in our understanding of the norm of reciprocity. Theoretical and practical implications are offered.

Trust and Reciprocity as Influenced by Group Identity Carey Fitzgerald, 2011 **Gender Differences in Trust and Reciprocity** Ananish Chaudhuri, Lata Gangadharan, 2003 **Trust and Reciprocity Among International Groups**

Kenju Akai, Robert J. Netzer, 2010. This paper explores national identity in trust and reciprocity at the intra and international levels by adopting a modified trust game played among groups from Austria and Japan in which subjects play the roles of trustor and trustee consecutively without any information feedback. Intra and international trust levels are identical across nationalities. Intranational reciprocity in Austria is greater than in Japan but there is no significant difference in international reciprocity between the two countries. We also examine the relationship between trust and reciprocity and the relationship between trust, reciprocity and expectations; demographic variables: the individualism index and trust indices. International trust enhances international reciprocity in both countries although this effect is weaker in Japan than in Austria. Expected returns enhance trust in both countries at the intra and international levels. In Japan, expected transfers enhance international reciprocity less than they do intranational reciprocity. A larger number of females in the group reduce international trust. In Austria, this reduces international trust more than it does intranational trust.

Trust and Reciprocity in Inter-Individual Versus Inter-Team Interactions Fei Song, 2007. Understanding social motives and norms of trust and reciprocity is essential for explaining many phenomena in organizations. A primary goal of this research is to extend past work on trust and reciprocity by examining the impact of the social contexts within which social interactions are characteristically embedded. Specifically, my research concerns whether norms of trust and reciprocity differ in the contexts of inter-individual and inter-group interactions when inter-team decisions are operationalized by individuals making decisions for their teams as team representatives. Methodologically, by employing the widely used experimental framework of the trust game with salient monetary payoffs, I examine the within-person variation of behavior and perceptions of trust and reciprocity in these two types of interactions that are pervasive in organizational life. Findings of the experimental study suggest that norms of trust and reciprocity can be affected by many subtle contextual details.

Trust, Reciprocity and Rules Thomas Rietz, 2017. Many economic interactions rely on trust which is sometimes violated. The fallout from business fraud and other malfeasance shows serious economic consequences of trust violations. Simple rules mandating minimum standards are attractive because they prevent the most egregious trust violations. However, such rules may undermine more trusting and reciprocal trustworthy behavior that otherwise would have occurred and thus lead to worse outcomes. We use an

experimental trust game to test the efficacy of exogenously imposed minimum standard rules Rules fail to increase trust and reciprocity leading to lower economic welfare Although sufficiently restrictive rules restore welfare trust and reciprocity never return The pattern of results is consistent with participants who are not only concerned with payoffs but also use the game to learn about trust and trustworthiness of others
