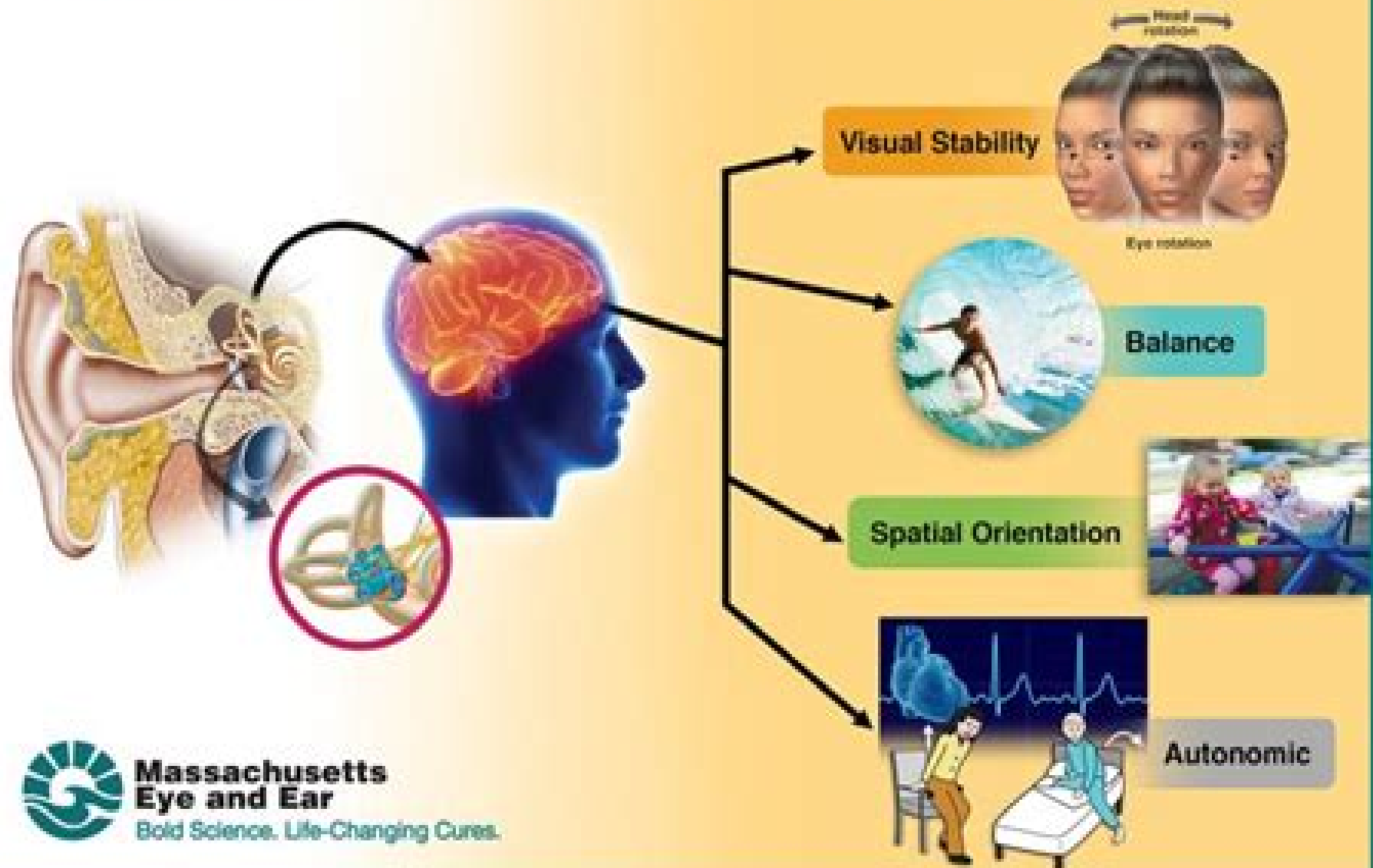

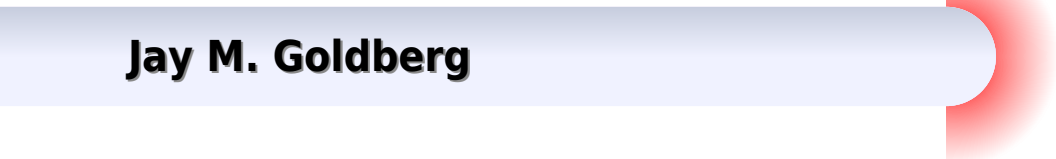

therefore has taken on particular importance in the study of human health in the Space Age. It is understandable then that NASA sponsored the Symposium on Vestibular Function and Morphology, a satellite of the Eighth Annual Meeting of the Society of Neuroscience, held October 30–November 1, 1978, at the University of Pittsburgh, which also supported the symposium. The present volume was developed from papers originally presented there.
