#### Taking a Thorough Medical History

- · A good history can yield closs that often help lead to a diagnosis
- Listen closely to what clients tell you and take notes.
- . If the information is not readily offered by the client, be sure to find out:
- Nature of current health challenge (symptoms noticed by chees)
- Onset and duration of current health challenge.
- Current vaccination and parasite control status.
- Past health issues (not already noted in medical record)
- Recent changes in:

- General patient savesament
- Physical exam findings, including vital signs.
