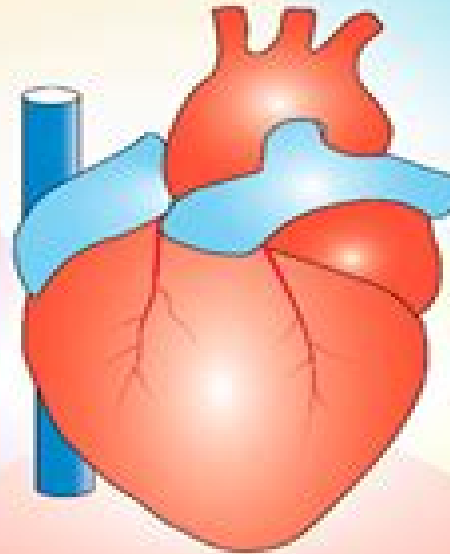

Rare diseases encompass a wide range of over 7 000 distinct conditions that affect a relatively small number of individuals. While each condition may be uncommon on its own, collectively they impact the lives of approximately 300 million people worldwide. These disorders can manifest in diverse ways, affecting various organ systems and potentially resulting in chronic pain, disability, and shortened lifespans. Moreover, the challenges patients and their families face extend far beyond the physical symptoms, encompassing emotional, financial, and social burdens that can be isolating and overwhelming. The complexity inherent in rare diseases poses one of their most daunting aspects. With such a vast array of conditions falling under this umbrella term, comprehending and diagnosing these disorders can be difficult and time consuming. The scarcity of research, limited treatment options, and a shortage of specialized medical professionals well versed in specific diseases further exacerbate patients' hardships. Consequently, the path to diagnosis can be fraught with misdiagnoses, delays, and pervasiveness of uncertainty, intensifying the distress experienced by individuals. Moreover, the relative scarcity of rare diseases often results in inadequate attention and funding. This resource disparity hampers research endeavors and impedes the development of innovative treatments and therapies that have the potential to improve lives significantly.

At STIAS, the Health in Transition theme includes a programme to address the epidemic rise in the incidence of non-communicable diseases (NCDs) such as Type 2 diabetes, hypertension, obesity, coronary heart disease, and stroke in Africa. The aim is to advance awareness, research capacity, and knowledge translation of science related to the Developmental Origins of Health and Disease (DOHaD) as a means of preventing NCDs in future generations. Donaldson, 2024-05-31 Turner syndrome TS occurs in approximately 1 2000 1 2500 live born female infants The diagnosis is based on a total or partial absence of an X chromosome Besides the characteristic phenotype TS is associated with multiple conditions Leading symptoms in this syndrome are short stature and ovarian dysgenesis leading to infertility in most cases Particular attention should be paid to congenital heart defects which affect approximately 20 50% of girls and women with TS and are directly related to an increased mortality in this patient group Additionally there is an increased risk of autoimmune diseases such as autoimmune thyroiditis and coeliac disease The other disturbances are kidneys abnormalities recurrent otitis leading to conductive hearing loss vision problems and mental health issues

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Infections, Chronic Disease, and the Epidemiological Transition Alex Mercer, 2014 In 1949 the U S National Cancer Institute NCI and the Canadian Department of National Health and Welfare DNHW commissioned a film eventually called Challenge Science Against Cancer as part of a major effort to recruit young scientists into cancer research Both organizations feared that poor recruitment would stifle the development of the field at a time when funding for research was growing dramatically The fear was that there would not be enough new young scientists to meet the demand and that the shortfall would undermine cancer research and the hopes invested in it Challenge aimed to persuade young scientists to think of cancer research as a career This book is the story of that forgotten film and what it tells us about mid twentieth century American and Canadian cancer research educational filmmaking and health education campaigns It explores why Canadian and American health agencies turned to film to address the problem of scientist recruitment how filmmakers turned such recruitment concerns into something they thought would work as a film and how information officers at the NCI and DNHW sought to shape the impact of Challenge by embedding it in a broader educational and propaganda program It is in short an account of the important but hitherto undocumented roles of filmmakers and information officers in the promotion of post Second World War cancer research

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
